Here are the next steps:

- 2) Plan the layout and design of the new space. Heather and Tom McAnerney will be the main coordinators for this project. Volunteers are welcome.
- 3) Begin packing (much less to pack and move this time), and leave the spaces at Gloria Dei better than we found them. Volunteers needed and dates TBA.
