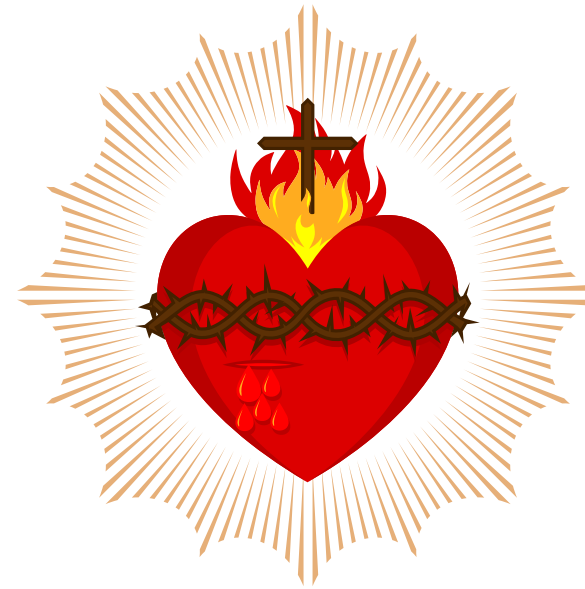
## The Nicene Creed

## Weekly Reflection

This Sunday, we observe the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, also known as Sacred Heart Sunday.

You may have seen conversations online in which some have sought to place devotion to the Sacred Heart in opposition to Pride Month. Whenever I see this, I often wonder if we have forgotten what the Sacred Heart actually reveals to us: that in Jesus Christ, every person is known, seen, and loved. The love of Christ is not poured out for a select few, nor is it reserved only for those whom the world has already deemed acceptable. The Sacred Heart burns with mercy for all who seek Him, especially those who have been wounded, excluded, or pushed to the margins.

You may also see verses of Sacred Scripture pulled from their context and used as weapons against the very people Christ has commanded us to love. As Catholics, we must be careful never to confuse faithfulness with cruelty, conviction with contempt, or holiness with the need to stand above others. The Gospel does not call us to self-elevation, but to conversion; not to fear, but to love; not to exclusion, but to communion.


There is another path for us as Catholics.

The way of love, true and unconditional love, does not mean that anything goes, nor does it dismiss the call to holiness, accountability, and growth. Rather, it opens the door for those who have been pushed to the peripheries, whoever they may be and for whatever reason, so that they may encounter Christ, experience genuine welcome, and find their place within a living community of faith.

At Good Shepherd, this is the path we are called to walk.

We do not have to choose between devotion to the Sacred Heart and love for our LGBTQ siblings, because the Sacred Heart itself teaches us how to love. It teaches us to make room. It teaches us to draw near. It teaches us to see each person not as an issue to be debated, but as a child of God to be received with dignity, tenderness, and grace.

So, this Sacred Heart Sunday, let us recommit ourselves to being a parish where the wounded find healing, where the excluded find welcome, where the weary find rest, and where every person who walks through our doors encounters not suspicion or shame, but the merciful love of Jesus Christ.
