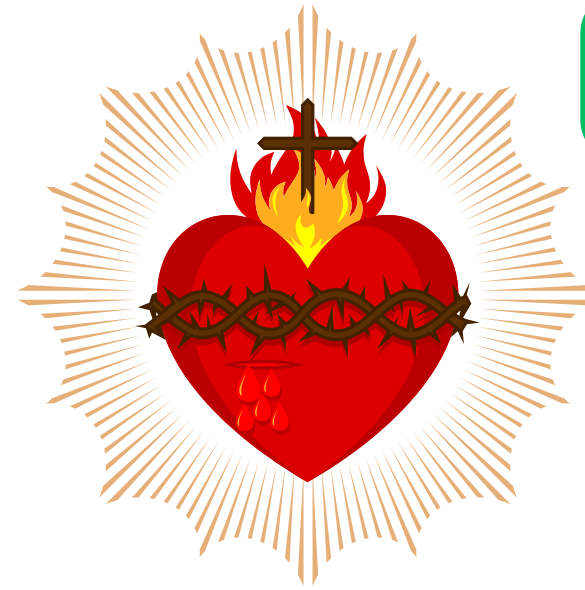
The Nicene Creed
