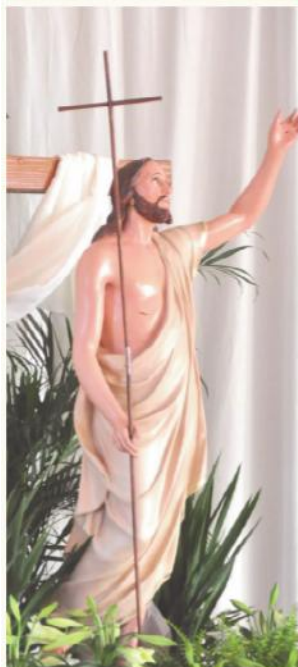

WEEKLY LETTER

May 22, 2022

Dear Friends,

One of the many themes that we hear throughout the teachings of Jesus is that phrase “be not afraid” or “do not let your hearts be troubled.” I think it is safe to say that not being afraid, having that sense of peace, trusting in Jesus and His presence in our lives is a main goal for Jesus and it should also be a goal for all of us. That peace that Jesus promises us is readily available to us if only we ask and believe that Jesus can and will be with us always and in Him, we find our hope and our salvation. It really does take depending on Jesus more and on ourselves less which, for many of us (me most of all) is a challenge as we like to be in control of our lives. That need to be in control can often be great as it can motivate us to do many good things however, when it comes to our faith lives, that need to be in control does not really work.

In this weekend’s Gospel, listening to Jesus preparing his disciples for His coming death and resurrection we hear Him encouraging them to not be afraid and yet, fear is filling their hearts, fear of the unknown, fear of losing Jesus, fear of what all of this might mean. With all the emotions of that moment, Jesus still encourages them, “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid.” The peace of Christ my friends will, if we allow it to, fill our hearts and center us on the love of Jesus who died, rose and ascended so that we could have new life and the Spirit of God always. With that truth in our hearts, what do we have to be afraid of?

This coming Thursday, May 26th is the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, a holy day of obligation. Mass will be celebrated in our community on Wednesday, May 25th at 7:00 pm and on Thursday at 7:00 am, 9:00 am, 12:00 pm and 7:00 pm. Please plan to join us as we celebrate this beautiful feast and give thanks to God for the gift of His resurrected Son.
