



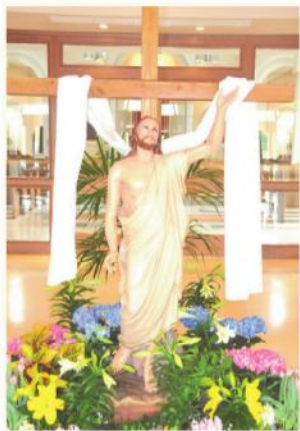

WEEKLY LETTER

April 23, 2023

Dear Friends,

Today as we continue our Easter celebration, we hear a very familiar and very beautiful Gospel which is commonly referred to as “The Road to Emmaus.” I really do love this Gospel as it offers so much for us to consider in our own lives and our personal journey of faith. The two disciples whom we meet in the Gospel are making their way to Emmaus after the crucifixion of Jesus. I wonder if we can even imagine how dejected they must have felt, it is palpable in so many ways. We can visualize this moment, the sadness, and the discouragement, we can hear it in what they say, “But we were hoping that he would be the one to redeem Israel” they are lost I believe and seem to be returning to their old lives with no hope.

And then Jesus joins them (although at that moment they do not know that it was Jesus) and walks along with them. I love how Jesus keeps them talking and then brings them slowly, steadily along the road of faith. “Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them what referred to him in all the Scriptures.” And then when it seemed as if he would leave them on the journey, he goes with them and while at table with them he takes the bread and breaks it and gives it to them, “With that their eyes were opened, and they recognized him.” That is so beautiful my friends, that journey of faith from despair to belief. Jesus lovingly and carefully brings them to the point where they leave the fear and anguish behind and embrace the reality that he has risen from the dead as he said he would.

In these days as we deal with so many challenges in our lives perhaps, we are a bit confused or weary, or dejected, or just tired. As understandable as that is, Jesus breaks into the midst of all of that and he walks along with us, and he opens our hearts and our minds to his love and his protection and to our life with him forever. Jesus has risen from the dead just as he promised, and nothing can ever change that reality. As we strive to recognize Christ in our lives, in our world, in our hearts may we spend more and more time with the Lord and may we be able to say with those disciples in Emmaus, “Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?”

Please mark your calendars for our parish celebration of 40 Hours beginning Sunday, on April 30th and going through Tuesday, May 2nd. We are pleased to welcome Father David Friel who will be our homilist for these days, which I know will be filled with grace for all of us. Father Friel is the Vocations Director for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia and I know you will enjoy his insights and his reflections. Please plan on joining us each evening at 7pm and throughout these 40 hours for time with the Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

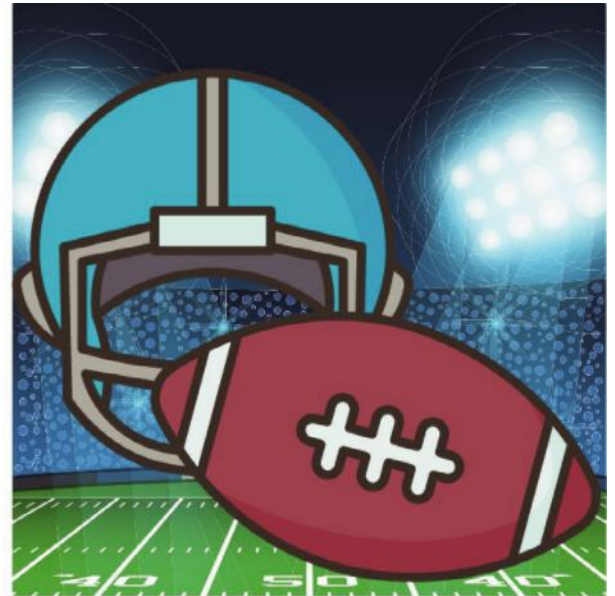
