



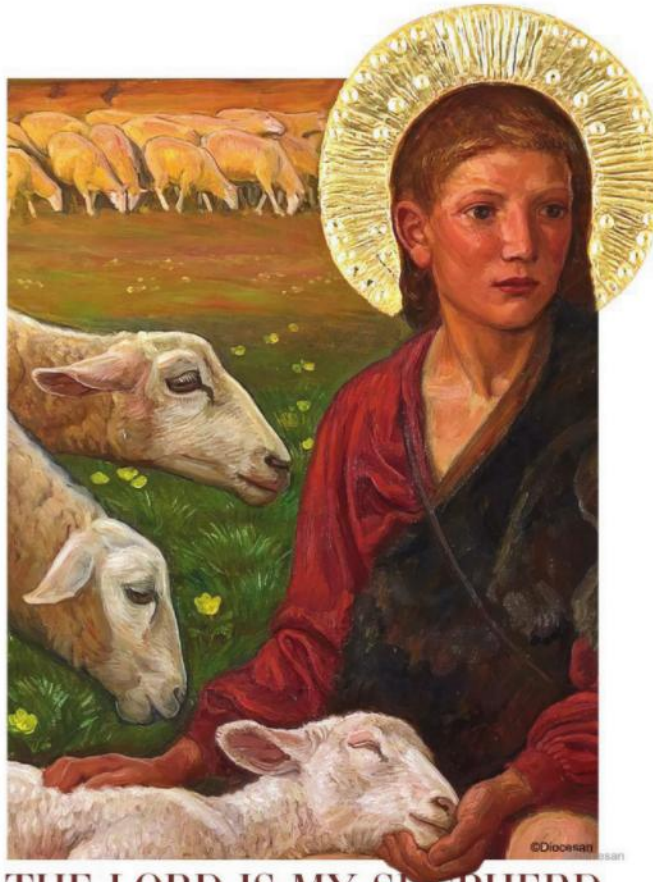
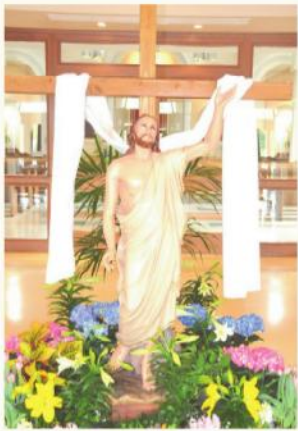

# WEEKLY LETTER

---

April 30, 2023

*Dear Friends,*

I am not sure if you are familiar with the Olney section of north Philadelphia where I grew up. It was a great place to be a kid, a wonderful neighborhood with what seemed to me at the time to be a great deal to do, I loved it. The thing about Olney is that it is not exactly the most “pastoral” of places meaning that we didn’t have large open fields for the most part, or rolling hills, or beautiful vistas to look at but boy, we had fun. The other thing we did not have was farm animals, no farm animals roaming the streets and sidewalks of Olney. When I read Gospels where Jesus uses thoughts and examples with sheep and shepherds and sheep gates and sheep folds, while I get it and I can grasp what Jesus is speaking about, I do not have a great deal of personal experience with these things.

“Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep. I am the gate whoever enters through me will be saved and will come in and go out and find pasture.” Truthfully even with my limited experience with sheep and sheep folds and all the rest, the point Jesus makes is a beautiful and important point. In a world such as ours where there are many voices and attractions that are clamoring for our time and our attention Jesus reminds us gently and sweetly that when we hear his voice and recognize the voice of the Lord then we hear the truth and, if we are smart people (which I have no doubt we are) we will follow the voice of Jesus and allow him to lead us to new life in and through him.

Isn’t that what we need, someone to lead us and speak to our hearts and offer us a place to find rest and peace and forgiveness and love? That someone is Jesus, and he offers us all those gifts and many more. Listen to the voice of the Lord, recognize that sweet, loving call that Jesus offers and then follow him without fear. He will never let us down.

Please remember to make time for the celebration of 40 Hours in our parish community (April 30-May 2). This graced time with Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament is a time of true blessing and joy for all of us. The Lord is waiting for us to greet him in prayer and reflection, may we all use these 40 Hours to grow closer to our Eucharistic Lord.

Please pray with me for our young boys and girls who will receive their First Holy Communion on May 6<sup>th</sup>. We are so proud of our young parishioners and so happy for them. May they always know the love of Jesus especially in the Eucharist which they will receive for the first time. God bless you always.

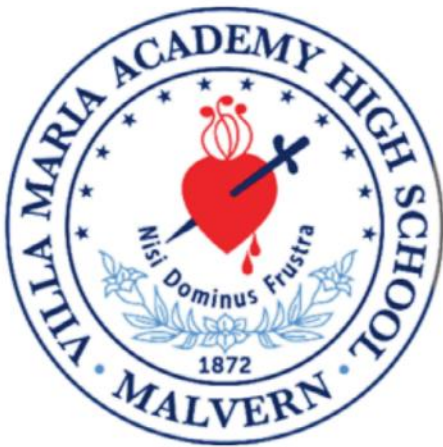
