

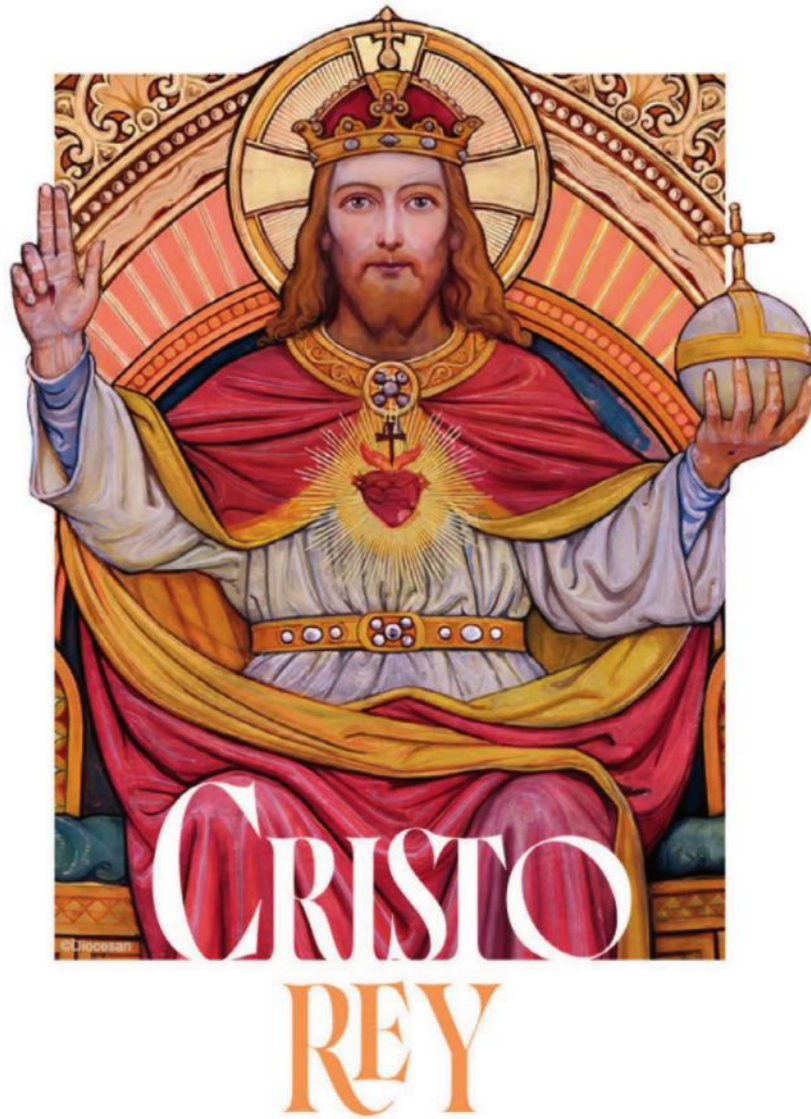

Weekly Letter

November 26, 2023

Dear Friends,

This Sunday is the last Sunday of our liturgical year, and we celebrate The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. This Solemnity is the perfect way for us to bring this liturgical year to a close and prepare ourselves for the new liturgical year to come. Our Gospel reading this weekend fits so beautifully with what we have been hearing lately from Jesus and it hopefully helps us to stop and consider what the Lord is asking of us as his followers. To hear Jesus say, "Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me," and also, "Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me," hopefully causes all of us to take a look at what we do and why we do it. In the end, my friends, I think it is fairly simple. Our lives as disciples of Jesus are meant to be about our outreach to others. Living our lives in such a way that in all we do and all we say others will see and hear Christ well, there is no greater work than this for the Christian disciple.

It means the world to others and helps us to share our blessings and show our gratitude.

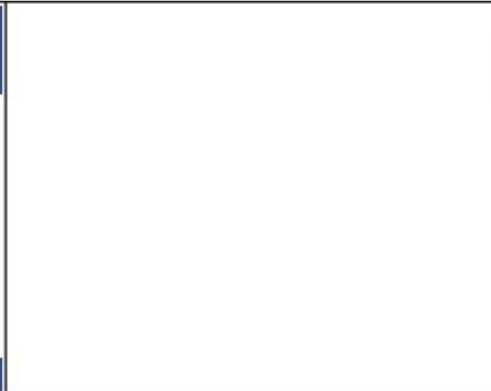
