Weekly Letter

December 3, 2023

Dear Friends,

This weekend we begin the Holy Season of Advent. The Church reminds us, "Advent has a two-fold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight."

I love that phrase, "devout and expectant delight." I think all too often we spend so much of our time looking for the next crisis or problem or sadness to come into our lives.
