Weekly Letter

April 14, 2024

Dear Friends,

As we continue our Easter celebration this weekend, we hear a beautiful Gospel that reminds us of something rather important. Jesus speaks to his Disciples after they have heard from the two brothers that encountered Jesus on the road to Emmaus and he reminds them of a very important truth, "And he said to them, Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."
