Weekly Letter

May 12, 2024

Dear Friends,

This weekend we read a beautiful Gospel that is part of Jesus' prayer of unity and these heart-felt words are such a source of grace for all of us. Jesus did and said so many wonderful and miraculous things during his public ministry and I am confident that besides leading us to an understanding of God's love for all of us and what our response to that love should be, the one over-riding prayer that Jesus has for all of us is that we will all be one in him. We hear Jesus pray, "Holy Father, keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are one." That my friends is what is at the heart of all that Jesus does and says, the unity of all people in Jesus and the Father.

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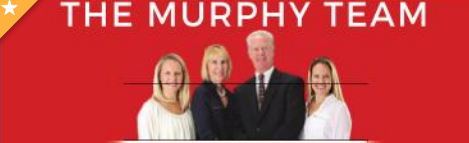

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
