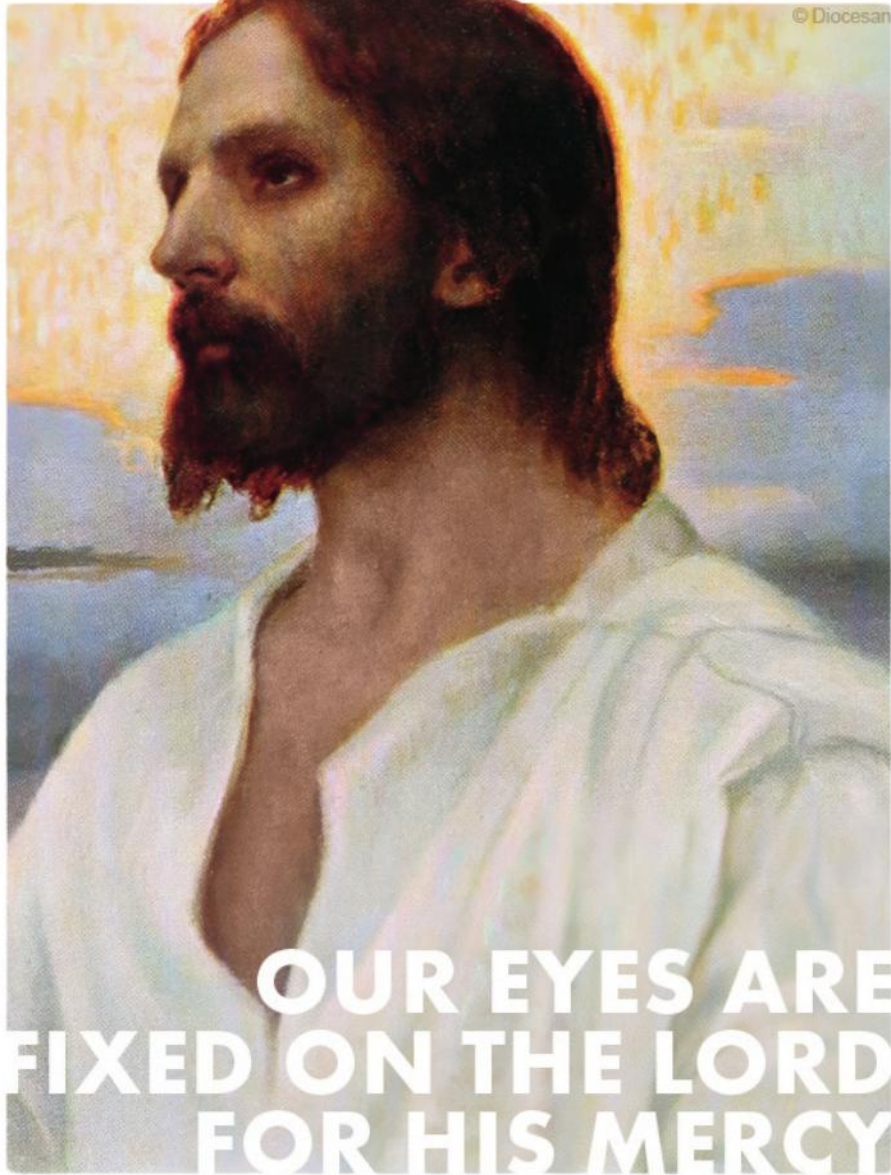

Weekly Letter

July 7, 2024

Dear Friends,

One of the most humbling experiences of my life as a priest (besides having to give a homily with my siblings in attendance) was going back to Cardinal Dougherty High School to celebrate Mass for my classmates for our 15th High School Reunion. The auditorium was packed (we had about 1,200 people in our class) and it was a little overwhelming to be honest. I muscled up the nerve and started Mass and gave a homily and prayed silently that they wouldn't laugh or throw things (it was the Olney section of the city after all) or walk out. To my surprise, the overall reaction to my being a priest was positive. Other than a friend or two from high school who thought I was dressing up like a priest for a joke, most of my classmates who were there were pretty kind and complimentary and supportive.

"Is he not the carpenter, the son of Mary, and the brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? Are not his sisters here with us? And they took offense at him." In a less dramatic way, I think I know how Jesus felt that day. For me some of the saddest words of Scripture are what we just heard, "and they took offense at him." They knew who Jesus was, they knew where he came from, who his relatives are, how he had grown up, what he did. That "knowledge" became a barrier for seeing who Jesus really is, the Son of God, the long-awaited Messiah.

Isn't that the danger of being so convinced that we know someone, or we know a certain situation, or we have information about something, and we are so sure that a person or things cannot possibly be any different? I think it is, I think that is what will keep us from seeing things as they truly are, or as they can perhaps be. The result of this "offense" that the people took at Jesus is that he "was not able to perform any mighty deeds there. He was amazed at their lack of faith." What we think we know can sometimes keep us from seeing what truly is, especially in our relationship with the Lord and with one another.

Jesus comes to us in many ways, through many different people, situations and experiences. Why would we ever limit the love and peace and joy of Jesus in our lives and in the lives of others? I truly believe that as his disciples in this world our mission is to experience Jesus in each person, situation and moment that the Lord gives us and celebrate his presence here with us. Doing that my friends brings Jesus more and more into the life of the world that can only be a good thing.

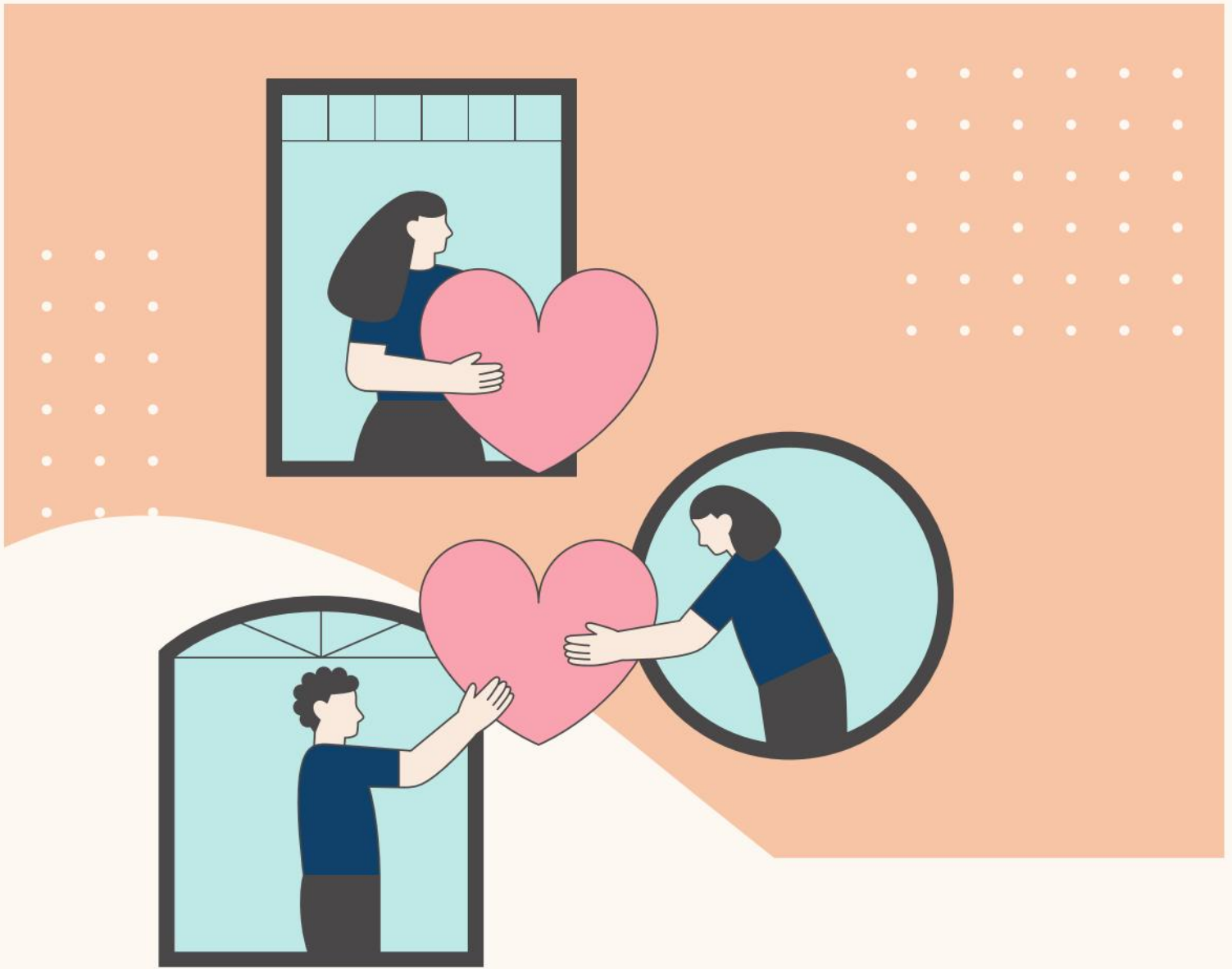

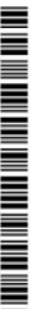

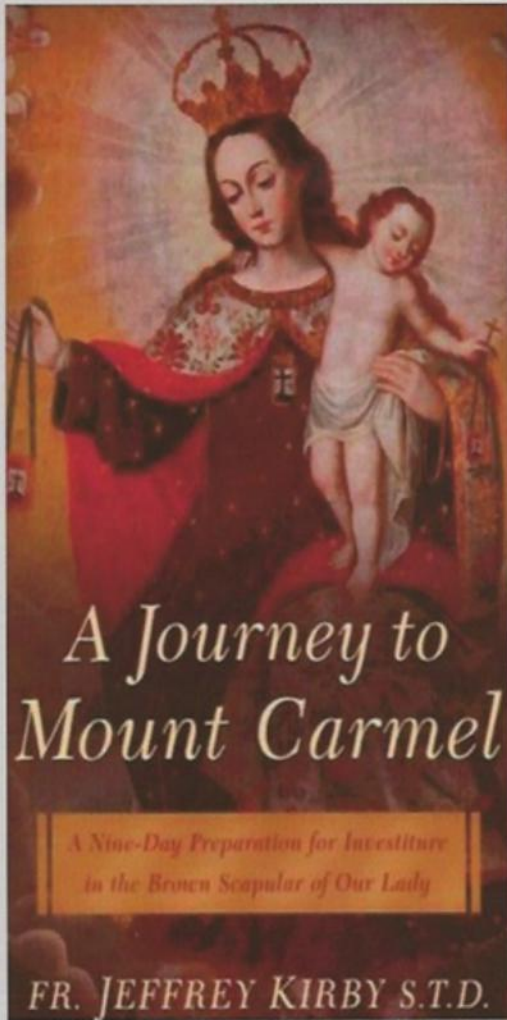
