Weekly Letter

August 4, 2024

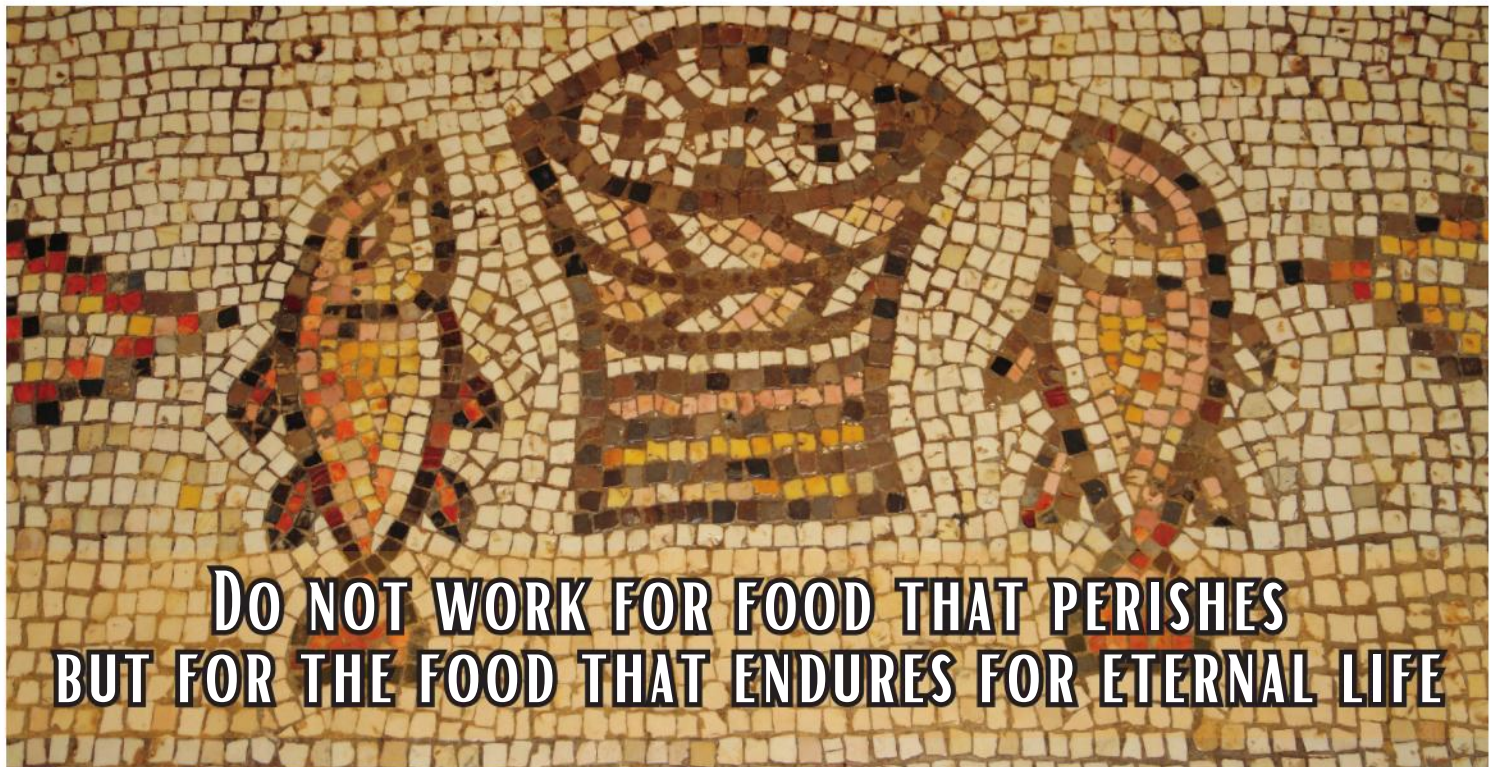
Dear Friends,

One of my favorite professors at Mount Saint Mary's Seminary who taught us Church History would always say to me, "Leva, stop making things more difficult than they have to be." I think in my younger days I did have a tendency to do that, to make things more involved or more difficult than they really needed to be. Now that I am older (and a lot grayer) I do not seem to do that as much, I am, it seems, able to take things as they come, as they are.

This weekend we read a Gospel that strikes to the heart of that same idea of making things more difficult than they have to be, especially when it comes to our faith life. Jesus had just recently taken the five loaves of bread and two dried fish and made a meal out of them that fed thousands of people and the crowds were amazed. Today we hear about the people losing track of Jesus for a moment and they are in a frenzy as they do not know where he is. When they find him they seem to be a bit miffed as to how and when and why he arrived and Jesus takes the opportunity to remind them that what they want is not to know him so much but rather for him to take care of them really. When Jesus impresses on them that they should be working to accomplish the works of God in their lives they honestly desire to know what they need to do to accomplish those works.

Jesus' answer to their question shows how they tend to make things more difficult than is needed, "This is the work of God that you believe in the one he sent." That is it, that is all they need to do, just have faith in Jesus, believe in him and they will be doing God's will in their lives. That my friends is the Christian mission, to believe in Jesus and allow Jesus to be the reason for all that we do and all that we say. Honestly Jesus does not micro-manage our lives, he loves us, he instructs us, he feeds us with his Body and Blood and then leaves the rest up to us. What we do with what he gives us, well that is up to us. Do not make things more difficult than they need to be, love Jesus, love one another and we will be doing the work of God in our lives and in the lives of all those we meet.

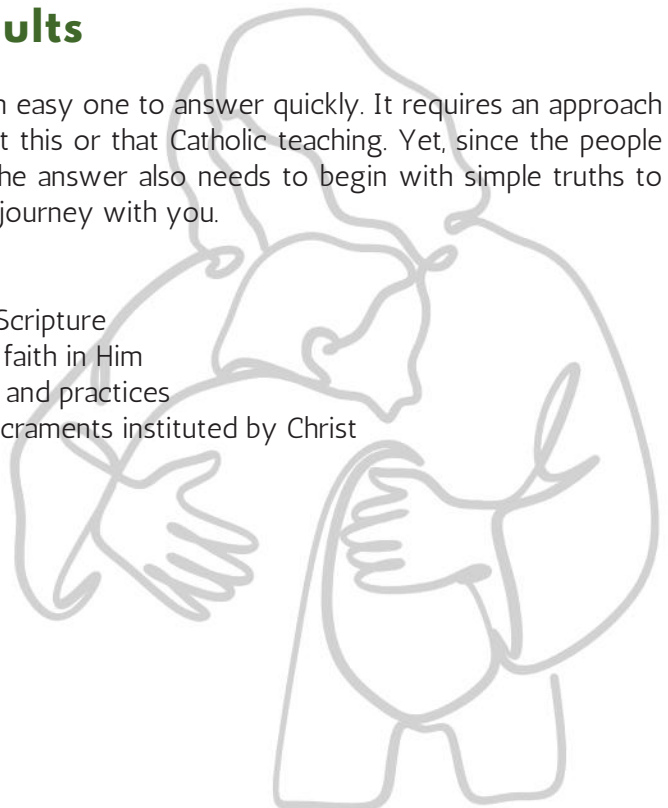
