The Parochial Vicar's Weekly Letter

October 27, 2024

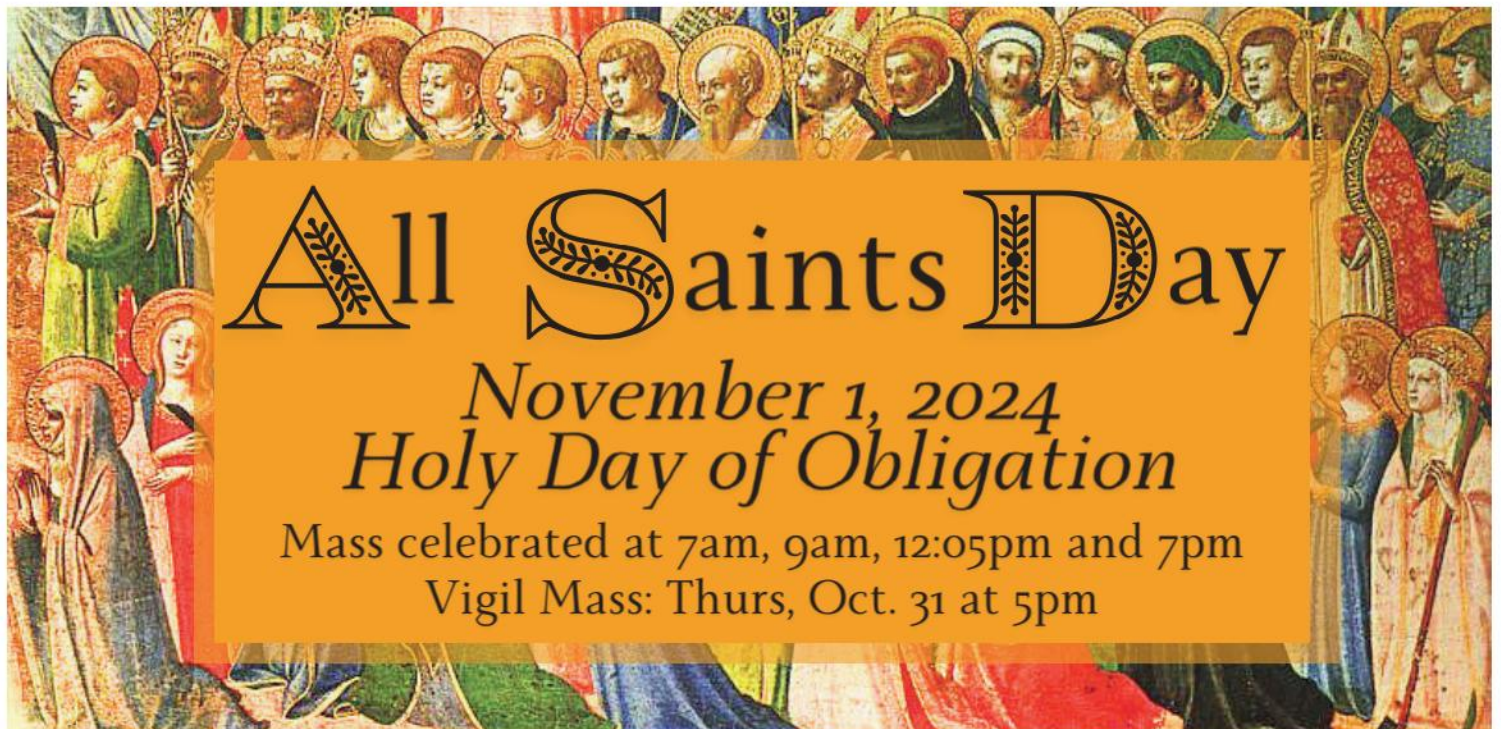
Dear Friends,

Fr. Leva has bestowed upon me the God given authority to write the weekly letter for the next few weeks. I accept this responsibility with tremendous honor and desire to do right by the Pastor and Almighty God! In all seriousness, the next few weeks are going to be interesting as we quickly approach the general election and we struggle with the final weeks of this (seemingly never-ending) political campaign. In the midst of such political turmoil which is characterized by vitriol, animosity, assassination attempts, personal slander, and ideological opposition, the message we receive from God this week in the Gospel is like a light in the midst of the darkness that is our social climate. The directive is to love God and love your neighbor.

The word "love" which Jesus uses here comes from the Greek word "Agape" which means complete and total self-gift. Agape type love is the love that configures our hearts to be like God's love for humanity. It helps lift our souls to heaven and gives us the insight to see others with the same perspective that God sees us. When we pursue growth in Agape type love, it means we must step out of our comfort zones. It's easy to love those who love us back, but agape calls us to love beyond our boundaries; to love those who we consider to be our adversaries. You might ask, how can we possibly love those who are against us or (God forbid) actively seek to harm us? The key here is to desire their good and wellbeing, even if they do not desire ours.

We live in a world that is gradually abandoning Jesus' message in the Gospels, but that does not mean we should abandon it as well. The reason why this political campaign is so exhausting is because genuine Agape type love seems to be absent. It is something that we as human beings crave in the depth of our hearts because it comes from God who is our source. The only way we can begin winning the hearts of those who are lost is if we grow in Agape ourselves. When people treat us with contempt, we should respond with kindness. When people slander us and speak ill of our character, we should respond with patient deference. When people want to see our downfall and destruction, we should desire to grow in community and connection with them. By loving our neighbor in this way, we grow in our proximity to the Lord. This is the only way our community and our country can grow in peace... it begins right here in Downingtown.

The King and Queen are Coming: Enthronement Weekend

Attention: At the end of all Masses this weekend, our "Enthronement Weekend", all are invited to enthrone the Sacred Heart of Jesus into their homes & consecrate themselves to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

What Does it Mean?

The word "enthronement" means to put upon a throne. In effect through enthroning Jesus into our homes we are inviting Him to become the King and head of our homes and of our hearts. In this way we are asking Jesus to guide us in our efforts to live good lives and to lead us to our Father in heaven.

In consecrating our families to the Immaculate Heart of Mary we are asking Mary as our spiritual Mother to extend her mantle of love, comfort and protection over our families. She will watch over us and lead us to a deeper relationship with her Son, Jesus.

Why is it Important?

It is a way to obtain special graces and blessings in our daily lives. Jesus said to Saint Margaret Mary "I will bless the homes in which an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored". To invite Jesus and Mary into our homes takes on even greater meaning in these troubled times and is a source of great comfort and grace.

How will it work?

At the end of each Mass on October 26 & 27, a short presentation will be given and Enthronement Packets will be distributed. The packets include beautiful images of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary and an Enthronement Scroll suitable for framing (and on which the names of the living and deceased family members are written). You get the pictures framed and then you come together as a family to put them in a place of honor in your home while saying the prayers from the Enthronement Scroll to complete the Enthronement and Consecration.
