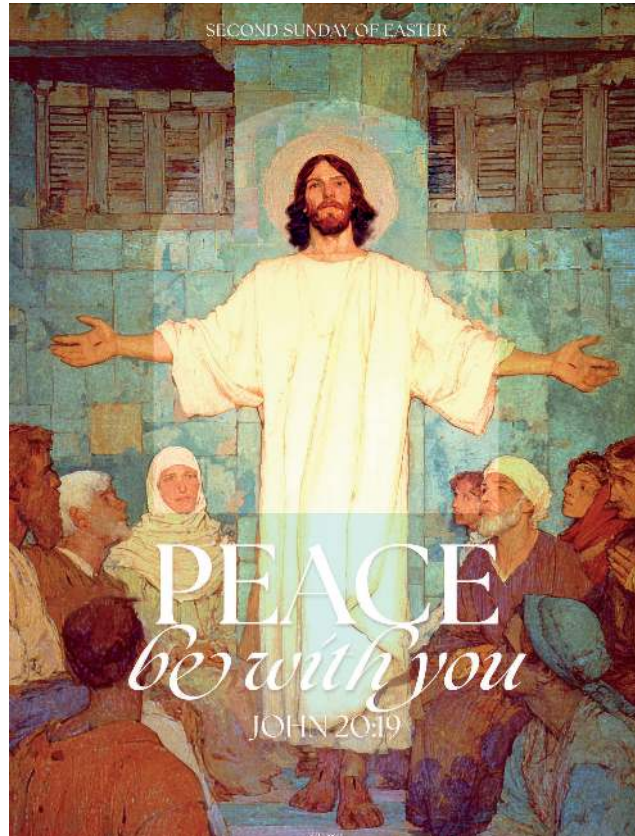

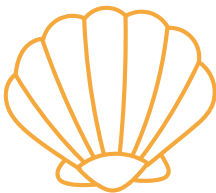

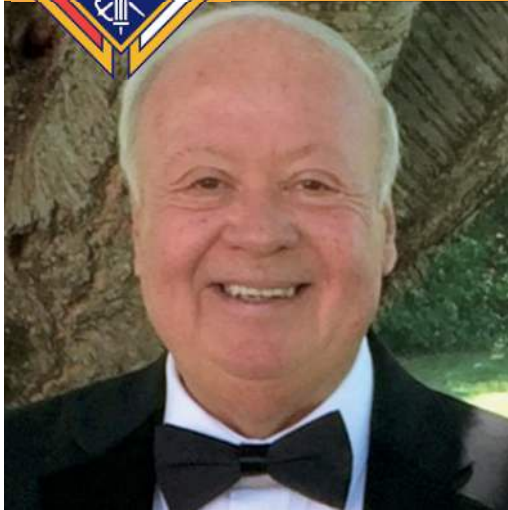

Dennis Calvey has been a proud and active member of St. Joseph's Parish and the Knights of Columbus Council 7208. Over his 10 years as a Knight, Dennis has held several positions—including Grand Knight, Deputy Grand Knight, Chancellor, and Advocate. He has also Coordinated numerous parish activities such as the Divine Mercy Cenacle, Bag Bingo, Easter Egg Hunt, and Peanut Butter & Jelly Drive.

You may see Dennis weekly at noon mass, as he has served as Head Usher for more than 30 years.

"For me," Dennis says, "being Catholic is not just one aspect of who I am—it is the story of my life."

As the Grand Knight, Dennis led our council through the challenges of COVID, while managing to coordinate the completion of the Nest Project. This accomplishment, he says, represented the perseverance, teamwork, and faith of the entire council.

Dennis's faith has been profoundly strengthened through personal trials, including his youngest daughter's critical illness and the loss of his wife, Bonnie. Through the intercession of Padre Pio and Our Lady of Garabandal, he witnessed miracles of healing and peace that deepened his devotion to God. 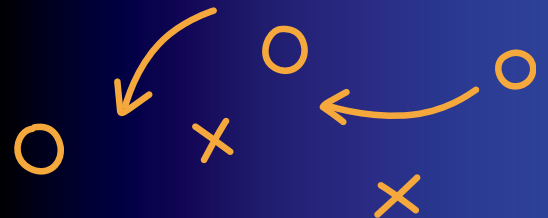

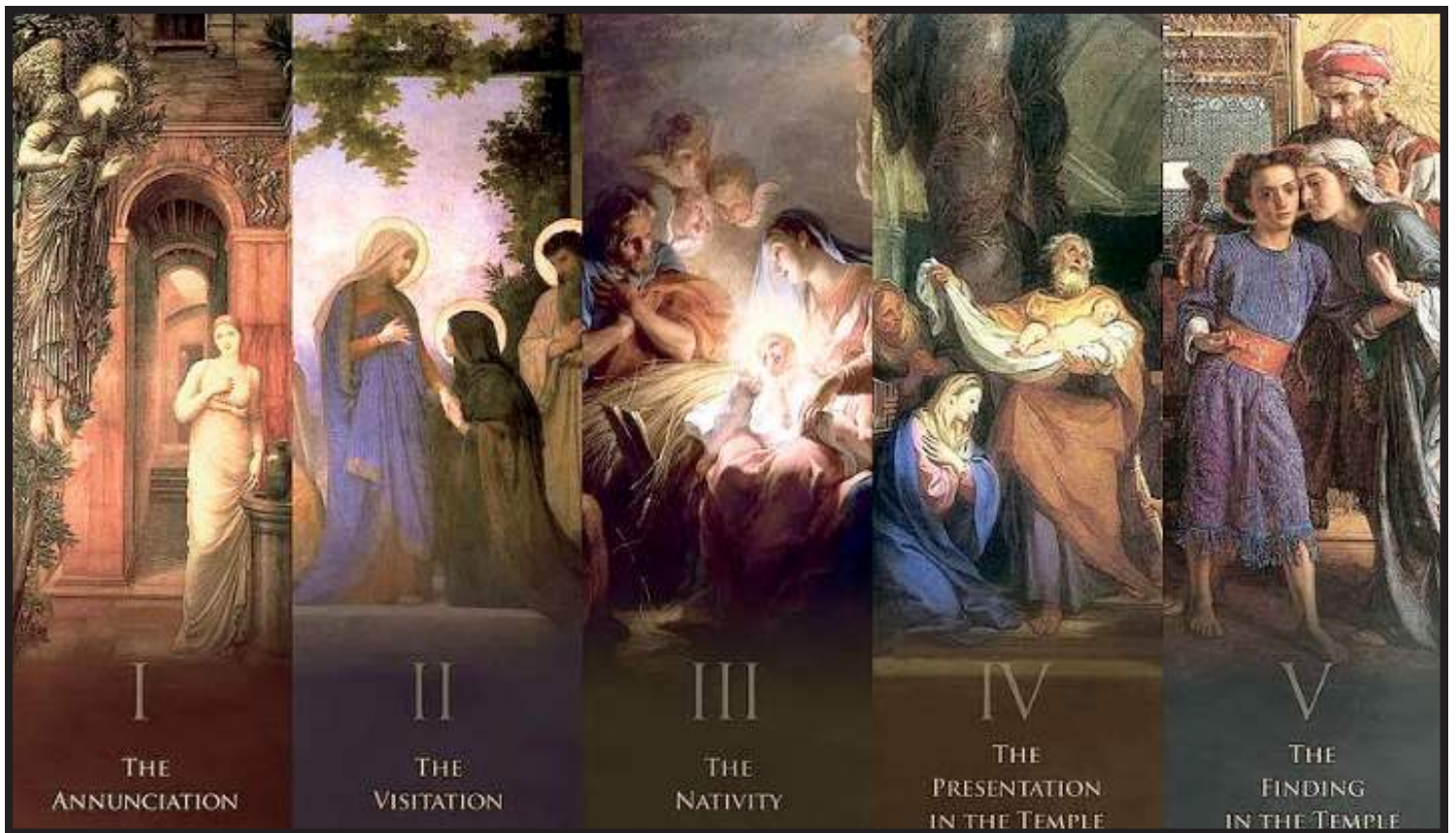
