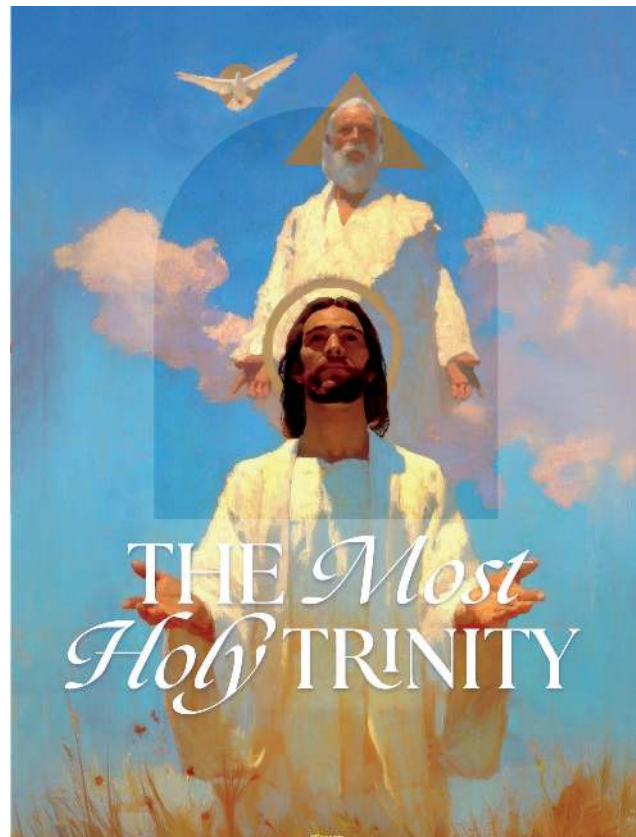

My Dear Parishioners,

Praise be Jesus Christ! With June now upon us, there is a great shift of gears not only from Easter into Ordinary Time but from School to Summer and with that shift, there are many graduations! This Tuesday, our parish school will honor our 8th grade graduates; last week, I attended our Pre-K "graduation" and on Wednesday I'll attend the Graduation Mass for Bishop Shanahan High School.

The word "graduation" comes from a Latin Word meaning "step". And in some way, we are all stepping. Hopefully, stepping up and out! We were made for such movement – out of self and further up into the Lord Jesus! We make such moves with others, whether it's with a Class; as a family; or as Church! We seek the counsel and company of those around us and together we move step-by-step, growing outward and upward in grace and charity.

As we move into Summer, I congratulate all graduates and promise my prayer. I also share a few items for your attention:

1) On June 11, 2026, the US Bishops will consecrate the nation to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus in honor of the 250th Anniversary of the founding of the United States. I encourage you to begin a Novena to the Sacred Heart this week on June 3rd and perhaps enthrone an image of the Most Sacred Heart in your home.

2) Next Sunday, we will have our Corpus Christi Procession after the Noon Mass and on Saturday, June 13 after the 5PM Mass, we will have a BBQ for Fr. Auletta.

3) Finally, each year, there are a few note-worthy graduation talks that inspire and pack a punch. Two are worth a google search: 1) That of Eric Church who gave a commencement talk at UNC Chapel Hill about the strings of a guitar! But even better that of 2) Msgr. James Shea who gave the commencement talk at Catholic University. I close with some of his words.

May God grant us the grace to Step-Out and Up, out of mediocrity and with greater confidence and love for God, ourselves and for others!

That is the only thing that I know of that helps us to contend with the great problem of our mediocrity."

AN UPCOMING VISIT FROM PHILADELPHIA SUNDAY, MAY 31, 2026

On Sunday, May 31, St. Joseph's will welcome Fr. Matthew Biedrzycki, Parochial Administrator of St. Malachy Parish and chaplain to the Temple Catholic Newman Center in North Central Philadelphia. Our pastor, Fr. Rogers, will be celebrating Mass at St. Malachy that same morning – a "pastor swap" intended to begin a friendship between our two communities.

St. Malachy is a historic urban parish serving the diverse neighborhood that surrounds it, and the Temple Catholic Newman Center is the spiritual home of Catholic students at one of the country's largest urban universities. Both St. Malachy and St. Joseph's celebrate their 175th anniversary this year – a shared milestone that lends our exchange of pastors a particular grace. Located only blocks apart, these two communities form a single missionary outpost in the heart of the city – a place of Eucharistic life, evangelization, and works of mercy through the parish's emerging Outreach Center. The parish enjoys a close partnership with the Sisters of Life, who host their monthly Holy Hour at St. Malachy and minister to students at the Newman Center.



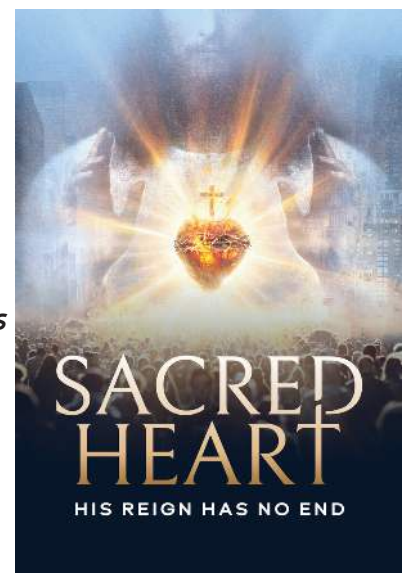
