\* Please make arrangements early to have your child at practice. There is only ONE practice for each group. Your child attends the practice which corresponds with the Mass during which they receive their First Holy Communion. May we suggest that you pick your child up at school or arrange carpooling so that everyone is on time. Early dismissal from school for Communion Practice is an acceptable excuse. Please also remember to give your child a snack before practice.

At the end of practice, children MUST be picked-up in the Church. Thank you.

#### Schedule for Reconciliation

#### Thursday, February 5, 2026 at 7:00 pm - All children

\*\*\*\* Note:

The rite of Penance will begin promptly at 7:00p.m.

Please arrive early enough to pick up your child's certificate envelope in the John Neumann room. The children will all sit together and their family and friends will be seated in the remainder of the available pews.

There will be NO seating in pews where confessions are being heard. We are fortunate to have 8-10 priests available to hear Confessions.

The children will be invited to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, then return to their pew where they will pray the Penance the priest has given them. When finished with the penance, catechists and teachers will help them find you. After all the children have receive the Sacrament for the first time, family members are encouraged to receive this Sacrament of God's love and forgiveness as well. Thank you.

#### **Dress Code for First Reconciliation**

We ask that the children dress respectably for Church and the reception of a sacrament.

there is NO picture taking, video or audio taping during the sacrament.

Children should arrive at the Daily Mass Chapel (Church) by 9:00 a.m. Parents, family and friends may go directly to the Church.

**12:00 noon Mass: GROUP 2 -** Children whose last name begins M through Z

Children should arrive at the Daily Mass Chapel (Church) by 11:30 a.m. Parents, family and friends may go directly to the Church.
