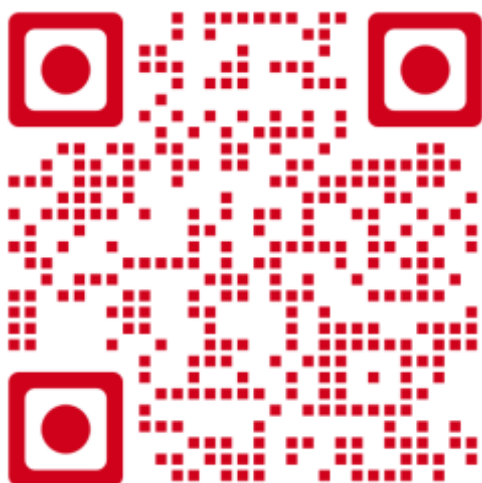

Pope Francis has called the universal church to enter a synodal process, invoking the Holy Spirit to guide the Church. This began with an Opening Mass by Pope Francis on October 10, 2021. Bishop Mueggenborg will celebrate three Opening Masses in the Diocese of Reno on October 17, 2021. The Masses are as follows:

- 9:30 am at the Cathedral of St. Thomas Aquinas. It will also be livestreamed. All are welcome to attend.
- 12:00 pm at St. Robert Bellarmine Parish in Fernley.
- 4:00 pm at St. Joseph the Worker Parish in Empire

The Prayer of the Synod: *Adsumus Sancte Spiritus*

This prayer, attributed to St. Isidore of Seville (560-636), has been traditionally used at Councils and Synods for hundreds of years. The version below was specifically designed for the Church's Synodal journey from 2021 to 2023.

*We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.
With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts;
Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it.
We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder.
Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.
Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life
and not stray from the way of truth and what is right.
All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time,
in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.*

El Papa Francisco ha llamado a la iglesia universal a entrar en un proceso sinodal, invocando al Espíritu Santo para guiar a la Iglesia. Esto comenzó con una Misa de Apertura del Papa Francisco el 10 de Octubre de 2021. El Obispo Mueggenborg celebrará tres Misas de Apertura en la Diócesis de Reno el 17 de Octubre de 2021. Las Misas son las siguientes:

- 9:30 am en la Catedral de Santo Tomás de Aquino. También se transmitirá en vivo. Todos son bienvenidos para asistir.
- 12:00 pm en la parroquia St. Robert Bellarmine en Fernley.
- 4:00 pm en la parroquia St. Joseph the Worker en Empire

Oración de invocación al Espíritu Santo para una asamblea eclesial de gobierno o discernimiento (es decir, sinodal): *Adsumus, Sancte Spiritus*

Esta oración, "Espíritu Santo", que se ha utilizado históricamente en Concilios, Sínodos y otras reuniones de la Iglesia durante cientos de años, siendo atribuida a San Isidoro de Sevilla (c. 560 - 4 de abril de 636). Al ser llamados a abrazar este camino sinodal del Sínodo 2021-2023.

*Estamos ante ti, Espíritu Santo, reunidos en tu nombre.
Tú que eres nuestro verdadero consejero: ven a nosotros,
apóyanos, entra en nuestros corazones.
Enséñanos el camino, muéstranos cómo alcanzar la meta.
Impide que perdamos el rumbo como personas débiles y pecadoras.
No permitas que la ignorancia nos lleve por falsos caminos.
Concédenos el don del discernimiento, para que no dejemos que
nuestras acciones se guíen por prejuicios y falsas consideraciones.
Condúcenos a la unidad en ti, para que no nos desviemos del camino de la verdad y la justicia,
sino que en nuestro peregrinaje terrenal nos esforcemos por alcanzar la vida eterna.
Esto te lo pedimos a ti, que obras en todo tiempo y lugar,
en comunión con el Padre y el Hijo por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.*

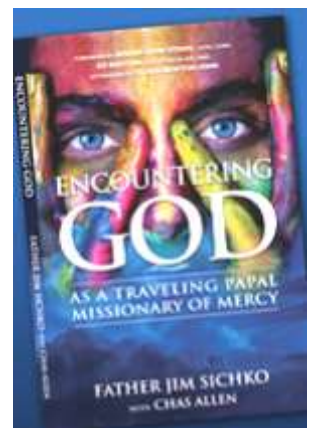
