

Bishop Mueggenborg's Gospel Reflection Pentecost Sunday June 8, 2025

Our Scripture passage comes from the Gospel of John 20:19–23. It is the scene of the Risen Christ sending the Apostles and "breathing" on them. It is an appropriate passage to reflect on as we celebrate the moment when the first disciples were enlivened by the Holy Spirit and filled with enthusiasm to continue the mission of Jesus.

The word "enthusiasm" comes from the two Greek words meaning "God within" (*en theos*). It refers to the experience a person has when they are "filled" with the Spirit of God. In the Greek world it was originally perceived as an arbitrary invasion of God into the psyche that filled the individual with an indomitable energy. This was the way the Greeks explained divine inspiration. In the Christian faith, however, to be enthusiastic is not only to be energetic; it is to be courageous, motivated, and committed. The disciples had that experience and thus began to carry on the mission of Jesus fearlessly as His witnesses even unto death. Because of their enthusiasm, they were able to do the things that Jesus did. The gift of the Spirit transformed their fear into faith. It motivated them from being self-preserving to becoming other-serving, and it changed the mission of the Church from merely a human organization into a holy endeavor. Wow—the Spirit can transform lives and communities!

- When in your life do you experience "enthusiasm" in the religious sense of being "filled with God"?
- What works of faith, as in the Mission of Jesus, have you been led to do as a result of your enthusiasm?
- What fears can cause people today to be "paralyzed" in their witness of faith and dampen their enthusiasm?
- How can people fulfill their religious observances with a "self-preserving" attitude rather than an "other-serving" attitude?



Is Pentecost really as important as Christmas and Easter?

Today we read about Pentecost's place in the Paschal Mystery. Youth minister Chris Mueller explains that Pentecost's role in that mystery makes this feast more important than it might seem.

The Third Great Feast

Yes, God came. He lived as a human. He died for our sins. He conquered death, rose to new life, and returned to heaven. Incredible! But once he is in heaven, aren't we basically in the same situation we were in before he came? If the story ends at the Ascension, we have no way to live our new life.

Christmas and Easter change reality, but they are not enough. They are only part of the story. God did not come to save us and then leave us. He planned something greater.

Jesus says as much in John's Gospel. At the Last Supper, Jesus teaches the disciples that something new is going to happen. Another Person is coming. This Person is so crucial that Jesus tells the apostles that it is better for him to leave so this new Person can come.

I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. (John 16:7)

Wrap your mind around that! Christmas is a big deal. Easter is a big deal. Jesus is saying that the coming of this next Person is a big deal, too—big enough that Jesus tells the apostles he needs to go so the Advocate can come. Right before his Ascension, Jesus talks again about this.

And while staying with them he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, he said, "you heard from me, for John baptized with water, but before many days you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit." (Acts 1:4-5)

Before returning to heaven, in essence, Jesus tells the apostles, "You are not done yet. Go wait for the Holy Spirit." So, they go to Jerusalem and wait. At Pentecost (the Jewish feast celebrating the giving of the Law), the unexpected happened:

And suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rush of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire, distributed and resting on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. (Acts 2:2–4)

The Fire of the Holy Spirit

The Advocate had arrived. God, in the Person of the Holy Spirit, had come. Just like Christmas celebrates the coming of Christ, Pentecost marks the arrival of the Spirit. At Christmas, we celebrate that God has come for us. In Pentecost, we rejoice that God has come to dwell within us.

Christmas, Easter, and Pentecost are the three great feasts of the Church. Without the third of these, we would still be distant from the Lord. Through the coming of the Spirit, we are made members of Christ's family, and in the Spirit, we are able to cry out, "Abba! Father!" (Galatians 4:6). Pentecost is important. Celebrate this great thing that God has done for us.

Ponder and Pray

- What do I think it means for Jesus to say, "It is better for you that I go" (John 16:7)? What does that say about the importance of Pentecost?
- How do I see the action and presence of the Holy Spirit in my life?

Make It Your Own

Pray to the Holy Spirit this week. Here is a prayer that you can say daily when you wake up in the morning. On the lines, write about what it means to you.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love.

Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth.

Let us pray.

O God, who have taught the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that in the same Spirit we may be truly wise and ever rejoice in his consolation. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.
