What is mortal sin?

Mortal sin is a grievous offense against the law of God.

Why is this sin called mortal?

This sin is called mortal because it takes away the life of the soul.

What three things are necessary to make a sin mortal?

To make a sin mortal these three things are necessary: first, the thought, desire, word, action, or omission must be seriously wrong or considered seriously wrong; second, the sinner must know it is seriously wrong; third, the sinner must fully consent to it.

What is venial sin?

Venial sin is a less serious offense against the law of God.

Do you remember your catechism? Do you remember what it takes for a person to incur the guilt of a mortal sin? To incur the guilt of a mortal sin three conditions are necessary. These conditions are:

2. The **sin's subject matter must be grave.**
3. The sin must be **committed with full knowledge** (and awareness) of the gravity of the offense.
4. The sin must be committed with deliberate and complete consent.

In other words, a person must have KNOWLEDGE that the sin is deadly, A person must WILL to commit the grave sin; and, the person must freely ACT upon the will and commits it.

If a man walked up to you and told you about a scheme he concocted with others that could poison every man, woman, and child in your hometown and in doing so, he stood to make billions of dollars and he invited you to participate in his scheme in order to make you rich, would you do it? Of course, you wouldn't!

Besides thinking the man a madman, your mind would go back to your hometown and you would think about the good people that live there; perhaps even your aged parents live in that town; siblings, old friends and neighbors. Perhaps it is Garrison, Max, or White Shield; and, you begin to think about the ramifications of supporting such a wicked thing.
