
Spirit to change our hearts, and minds. We can be resistant to this change, even when we know it is the best that could happen to us.

and dates back to the early days of Christianity. In later centuries, Christians observed the circumcision of Jesus on that day, seven days after His birth as is customary in the Jewish tradition. In 1965, the Vatican set aside that practice and replaced it with the ancient tradition of dedicating the day to Mary.
