Wishing all the amazing moms a Happy Mother's Day filled with love, appreciation, and happiness!

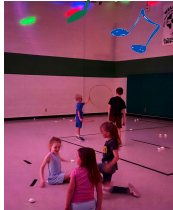




Gala fun days

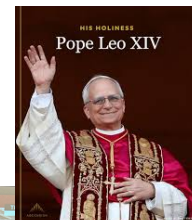
