Katherine prononcera ses premiers vœux...

After 10 years of actively discerning religious life, having entered 3 different religious communities (1 cloistered and 2 active-contemplative), teaching grade 4 as a lay teacher, and having lived in 3 countries, I resigned myself to having what I described as a "weird vocation". I knew that God had called my heart to remain in undivided love for Him by way of celibate chastity. I knew that He called that same heart to the apostolate, that all hearts might return to the heart of the Heavenly Father through His only begotten Son in the gentle school of Mary. It seemed however that there was nowhere where my heart was intended to "land" in the official structure of the Church by way of "state in life vocation".

Then a beautiful thing happened... I let go of the idea I thought God had for my life, and simply lived in the moment as His. It was then, my heart freed from a particular attachment to what my vocation was, that I found my vocation.

Now, on **November 6th in Maddison Connecticut** (if I can get there in our present circumstances) I will be making my 1st vows of poverty, celibate chastity, and obedience as a member of the Secular Institute of St. Francis de Sales – a community dedicated to helping our fellow brothers and sisters encounter Jesus through the gentle path to holiness according to the wisdom and spirit of the Saint whose name we bear. Secular Institutes are the newest form of consecrated life in the Church. Its members make vows but live in the world retaining their lay character.

Après 10 ans de discernement actif de la vie religieuse, être entrée dans 3 communautés religieuses différentes (1 cloîtrée et 2 actives-contemplatives), avoir enseigné en 4e année en tant qu'enseignante laïque et avoir vécu dans 3 pays, je me suis résignée à avoir ce que j'ai décrit comme une « vocation étrange ». Je savais que Dieu avait appelé mon cœur à rester dans un amour pour Lui sans partage en choisissant la chasteté célibataire. Je savais qu'il appelait ce même cœur à l'apostolat, afin que tous les cœurs puissent retourner à celui du Père céleste par l'intermédiaire de son Fils unique, dans la douce école de Marie. Il semblait cependant qu'il n'y avait nulle part où mon cœur était destiné à « se poser » et où mes vœux officiels étaient reconnus par l'Église.

*Puis une chose merveilleuse s'est produite... J'ai abandonné l'idée que Dieu avait des plans pour ma vie, et j'ai simplement vécu le moment présent. C'est alors que, mon cœur étant libéré de tout attachement à une vocation, j'ai trouvé **ma vocation**.*

*C'est ainsi que le **6 novembre prochain à Maddison dans le Connecticut (USA)** (si j'y arrive étant donné les circonstances actuelles), je prononcerai mes 1ers vœux de pauvreté, de chasteté célibataire et d'obéissance en tant que membre de l'Institut séculier de Saint-François de Sales - une communauté dédiée à aider nos frères et sœurs à rencontrer Jésus à travers le doux chemin de la sainteté, selon la sagesse et l'esprit du Saint dont nous portons le nom. Les instituts séculiers sont la forme la plus récente de vie consacrée dans l'Église. Ses membres prononcent leurs vœux mais vivent dans le monde en conservant leur caractère laïc.*

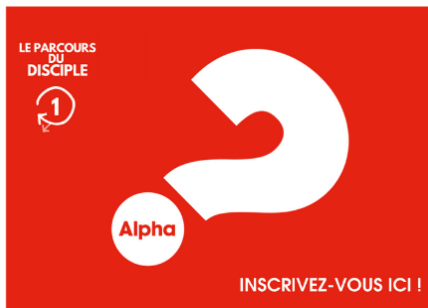

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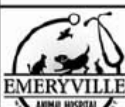

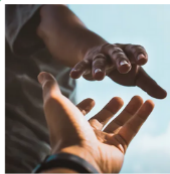
NEW HOME FOR LIST OF NAMES OF THE SICK

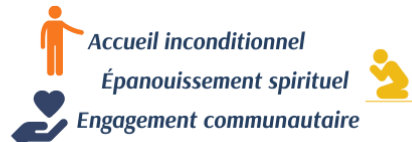

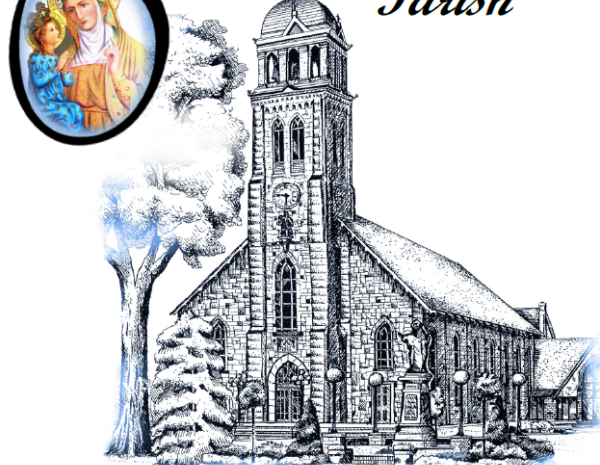

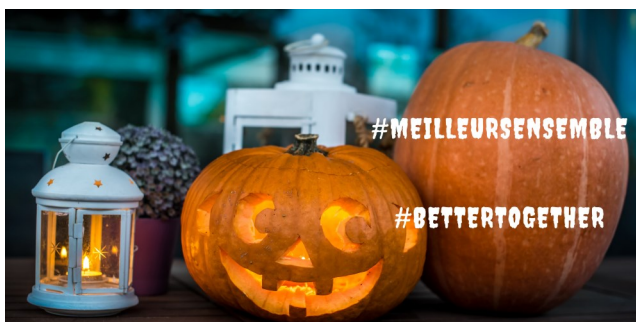
