The term "Jubilee" has been used in Catholicism since 1300 in connection with the Holy Year in which the pope grants special spiritual benefits (indulgences) for those who make a pilgrimage to Rome and perform other religious acts. The term Jubliee reflects an older Jewish tradition where every fiftieth year the land was to lie fallow, debts were forgiven and slaves were freed. Holy Year Jubliees are now celebrated every 25 years unless a special occasion warranted an extraordinary year be proclaimed as with the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy in 2015-2016.

The Jubilee Year of Prayer

On January 21, 2024, Pope Francis announced a Year of Prayer ahead of the 2025 Jubilee, calling on the faithful "to pray more fervently to prepare ourselves to live properly this grace-filled event and to experience the power of hope in God."




