Réflexions sur l'Advent

Nous sommes à nouveau entrés dans la période de l'Advent. C'est le moment de se préparer à commémorer la naissance de Jésus et d'attendre son retour. Nous avons des décorations à faire, des cadeaux à acheter, des gâteaux à préparer, etc. Pourquoi faisons-nous tout cela ? Parce que Noël approche ! Cependant, si nous oublions la véritable raison de Noël, c'est-à-dire célébrer l'Incarnation et ce que cela signifie pour chacun d'entre nous d'un point de vue spirituel, alors ce n'est qu'une succession d'agitation et peut-être une pile de factures de carte de crédit impayées. Assurez-vous de réserver du temps pour préparer votre cœur également !

La couronne de l'Advent est un élément courant dans de nombreux foyers pendant l'Advent et elle sera également présente dans notre foyer « commun », l'église. Chaque semaine, nous allumons une bougie pour nous rappeler que le Christ, la Lumière du monde, est venu et reviendra. Nous devons refléter cette lumière et la transmettre aux autres. Lorsque vous allumez chaque jour la bougie de votre couronne de l'Advent, ou si vous n'avez pas de couronne, faites-le symboliquement en priant :

Ô Dieu, dans la joie, nous nous souvenons de la promesse de ton Fils.

Alors que nous allumons cette bougie, que la bénédiction du Christ descende sur nous, illuminant notre chemin et nous guidant par sa vérité.

Que le Christ, notre Sauveur, apporte la vie dans les ténèbres de notre monde et en nous, alors que nous attendons sa venue. Par le Christ notre Seigneur. Amen.
