And as a result of her leave and the departure of Katherine during the summer, we have been looking at the need for some changes. We have been "managing" over the last few months, but now we are going to be making some more long-term changes. Christa has offered to become the L.E.M. for ministry for youth from grades two to seven. Within her age groups, she will be responsible for the First Reconciliation and First Eucharist preparation programs in English, youth groups, altar servers, RCIA adapted for children, and ministry/presence in the English schools. The diocese will be soon posting a position for an L.E.M. responsible for Baptism, Senior Ministry, Children's Ministry, and Outreach in our Family of Parishes while Catherine is on leave (watch our website for further details).
