### ***What happens at Pentecost?***

In the Christian tradition, Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered together in the Upper Room.

A “strong, driving” wind filled the room where they were gathered, and tongues of fire came to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages so that they could understand each other. It was such a strange phenomenon that some people thought the Christians were just drunk — but Peter pointed out that it was only the morning, and said the phenomenon was caused by the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit also gave the apostles the other gifts and fruits necessary to fulfill the great commission — to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. It fulfills the New Testament promise from Christ (Luke 24:46-49) that the Apostles would be “clothed with power” before they would be sent out to spread the Gospel.

### ***Where’s that in the bible?***

The main event of Pentecost (the strong driving wind and tongues of fire) takes place in [Acts 2:13](#), though the events immediately following (Peter’s homily, the baptism of thousands) continue through verse 41.

### ***Happy Birthday, Church!***

It was right after Pentecost that Peter, inspired by the Holy Spirit, preached his first homily to Jews and other non-believers, in which he opened the scriptures of the Old Testament, showing how the prophet Joel prophesied events and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

### ***La descente de l’Esprit Saint***

L’événement de la Pentecôte survient dix jours après l’Ascension du Christ, après que Jésus a promis à ses disciples qu’ils vont « recevoir une force, celle du Saint-Esprit qui viendra sur vous. Alors vous serez mes témoins à Jérusalem, dans toute la Judée et la Samarie, et jusqu’aux extrémités de la terre »

Ce jour-là, soit cinquante jours après Pâques, les apôtres et Marie sont réunis dans le Cénacle pour célébrer la fête de Chavouot. Soudain, « un bruit survint du ciel comme un violent coup de vent : la maison où ils étaient assis en fut remplie tout entière. Alors leur apparurent des langues qu’on aurait dites de feu, qui se partageaient, et il s’en posa une sur chacun d’eux. Tous furent remplis d’Esprit Saint : ils se mirent à parler en d’autres langues, et chacun s’exprimait selon le don de l’Esprit. »

### ***Que célèbre-t-on à la Pentecôte ?***

#### ***La promesse du salut universel***

Recevant l’Esprit Saint, les apôtres sont investis d’une nouvelle mission : celle de témoigner de la vie et de l’enseignement de Jésus. Les langues de feu qui leur apparaissent signifie qu’il leur est désormais possible de s’exprimer dans d’autres langues que l’araméen. Ils peuvent donc diffuser la Bonne Nouvelle « à Jérusalem, dans toute la Judée et la Samarie, et jusqu’aux extrémités de la terre. » (Ac 1, 8).

C’est donc l’accomplissement non seulement de la promesse qu’a faite Jésus à ses disciples, lors de son Ascension, mais aussi celui de la promesse du salut universel. En envoyant l’Esprit de son Fils aux humains, Dieu manifeste le signe d’une Alliance nouvelle avec son peuple (comme cela l’a été prophétisé par Jérémie et Ézéchiël dans l’Ancien Testament).

### Archbishop James CSC MacDonald

Well known to many people in the Diocese of London, Archbishop James CSC MacDonald passed away earlier this week at the age of 100. He was ordained a priest in Woodstock in 1953 and in 1978 he was named Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of Hamilton. In 1982 he was appointed Bishop of the Diocese of Charlottetown and in 1991 he was named Archbishop of the Archdiocese of St. John's, until January 2001. Upon becoming Archbishop Emeritus of St. John's, he retired to Windsor where he continued auxiliary ministry in the Dioceses of London and Hamilton. 
