IMPORTANT

DIOCESE OF LONDON PARISH BRIEFING

In 2013 Bishop Fabbro wrote to the priests of the Diocese of London reminding them of the 1998 statement by Bishop Sherlock banning any activities in the Diocese of London by the BNP Movement (Banal Na Pag-aaral, aka Holy Studies Group). This "movement" originated in the Philippines and came to be seen as having aspects contrary to the teachings of the Church. This week, it has come to our attention that this movement is trying to re-establish retreats in the Diocese, particularly in the Windsor-Essex deanery.

As Bishop Fabbro directed:

No BNP activities are permitted in any London diocesan facility or any institution that is connected to the Diocese of London (schools, hospitals, retreat centres, etc.).

No member of the clergy is permitted to participate in any activity sponsored by BNP including the celebration of the sacraments.

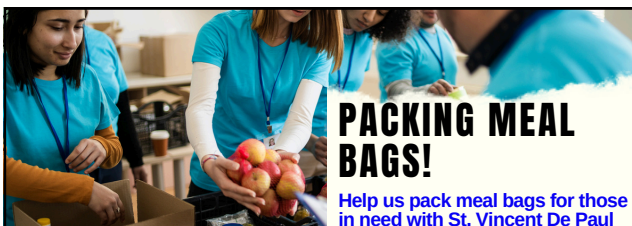
