Bien que déçu, je respecte leurs décisions. Je les remercie pour tout le travail qu'elles ont accompli dans nos paroisses. Nous avons la chance d'avoir des personnes très douées parmi notre personnel et nous devons leur être reconnaissants pour leur travail et leur dévouement. Je consulterai notre équipe pastorale et notre personnel de soutien pastoral au cours des prochaines semaines afin de déterminer la meilleure façon de procéder pour notre famille à l'avenir.
