From the Pastor's Pen ~

When Bishop Fabbro introduced the Family of Parishes model into our diocese, it was to address the declining number of parishioners and the declining number of priests. He also wanted us to focus our ministry on "mission" and to move away from merely "maintaining" our parishes. He noted the need for parishes to collaborate with one another to best use the limited resources available to avoid duplication and create a mission-oriented Church that forms disciples of Jesus. As we strive to move forward to fulfill the Bishop's vision for our Family, it will require us to view our call to discipleship in a different way. With those limited resources, how can we best serve our people within our Family of Parishes and in union with other Families of Parishes? This will be one of the key questions used to evaluate how and what we offer for ministry.

Two areas that some people have been asking about since I have arrived is the Healing Mass that occurred each month and the French language Mass once a month at St. Simon and St. Jude. The Healing Mass was a particular passion and charism of Fr. Bernard, who is no longer part of our Family. He had a special gift for this form of ministry outreach, and many benefitted from this. There is no denying the value of this ministry, and as a Windsor-Essex Deanery, we are blessed to have a parish that is already offering this ministry the First Friday of each month at 7:00 p.m. Anyone interested can attend this healing mass at Immaculate Heart Church (153 Parkwood, Windsor) on the First Friday of every month. The next Mass will be October 3rd at 7:00 p.m. Thus, it is not practical for us to re-institute this Mass here. Regarding the second area, we have two French language Masses each weekend: every Saturday evening at 16h30 at Ste. Anne Church and every Sunday at St-Jerome Church at 10h. So, within our Family, we already have two French language Masses available every week that Fr. Christophe celebrates for those who wish to worship in French. Thus, "duplicating" what we already are offering within the Family does not meet the Bishop's criteria to use our limited resources wisely. So, diocesan leadership has directed us to cancel the monthly Mass.

On another note, we have a group at Ste. Anne Church who has offered 100 Masses for the "Souls in Purgatory and world peace... and a gift of gratitude of released souls". Each day, from September 19th to December 28th, a Mass has been offered from this group. So, join with them in praying for the release of souls from purgatory into our Lord's eternal presence.

De la plume du pasteur ~

Lorsque Mgr Fabbro a introduit le modèle de la famille de paroisses dans notre diocèse, c'était pour répondre à la baisse du nombre de paroissiens et de prêtres. Il souhaitait également que nous concentrons notre ministère sur la « mission » et que nous nous éloignions de la simple « opération au jour le jour » de nos paroisses. Il a souligné la nécessité pour les paroisses de collaborer entre elles afin d'utiliser au mieux les ressources limitées disponibles, d'éviter le dédoublement et de créer une Église orientée vers la mission qui forme des disciples de Jésus. Alors que nous nous efforçons d'aller de l'avant pour réaliser la vision de l'évêque pour notre famille, nous devons envisager notre appel à devenir disciples d'une manière différente. Avec ces ressources limitées, comment pouvons-nous servir au mieux les membres de notre famille de paroisses et en union avec d'autres familles de paroisses? Ce sera l'une des questions clés qui nous permettront d'évaluer comment et ce que nous offrons pour le ministère.

Depuis mon arrivée, deux sujets reviennent souvent dans les questions que l'on me pose : la messe de guérison qui avait lieu chaque mois et la messe en français une fois par mois à St-Simon et St-Jude. La messe de guérison était une passion et un charisme particuliers du père Bernard, qui ne fait plus partie de notre famille. Il avait un don spécial pour cette forme de ministère et beaucoup en ont bénéficié. La valeur de ce ministère est indéniable et, en tant que doyenné de Windsor-Essex, nous avons la chance d'avoir une paroisse qui offre déjà ce ministère le premier vendredi de chaque mois à 19 h. Toute personne intéressée peut assister à cette messe de guérison à l'église Immaculate Heart (153 Parkwood, Windsor) le premier vendredi de chaque mois. La prochaine messe aura lieu le 3 octobre à 19 h. Il n'est donc pas pratique pour nous de rétablir cette messe ici. En ce qui concerne le deuxième point, nous avons deux messes en français chaque fin de semaine : le samedi soir à 16 h 30 à l'église Ste-Anne et le dimanche à 10 h à l'église St-Jérôme. Ainsi, au sein de notre famille, nous avons déjà deux messes en français chaque semaine, célébrées par le père Christophe pour ceux qui souhaitent célébrer la messe en français. Par conséquent, offrir deux fois ce que nous offrons déjà au sein de la Famille ne répond pas aux critères de l'évêque qui souhaite que nous utilisions nos ressources limitées à bon escient. Les responsables du diocèse nous ont donc demandé d'annuler la messe mensuelle.

Par ailleurs, nous avons un groupe à l'église Ste-Anne qui a offert 100 messes pour « les âmes du purgatoire et la paix dans le monde... et en signe de gratitude pour les âmes libérées ». Chaque jour, du 19 septembre au 28 décembre, une messe a été offerte par ce groupe. Joignez-vous donc à eux pour prier pour la libération des âmes du purgatoire et leur entrée dans la présence éternelle de notre Seigneur.
