And if none of those are possible, then at least offer up a little prayer for them in their time of need to Mary, Our Lady of Lourdes.

I was told by our Building Committee representative that "The long standing claim that our parish held against construction deficiencies has been settled to the satisfaction of both our parish and the Diocese of London".
