From the Pastor's Pen ~

Sunday Reflection

In our Gospel this weekend Jesus asks the blind man, "do you believe in the Son of Man?" Believing appears to be a key concept for Jesus. According to Jesus, believing helps us avoid condemnation, believing leads to eternal life versus not believing and being condemned and perishing. We often refer to ourselves as believers. We recite the creed each week where we boldly proclaim, "I believe" multiple times. What is it that we believe? Do we believe that Jesus is the Son of God, who died, was buried and rose from the dead? Do we believe in the Father and the Holy Spirit? Do we believe in the Real Presence in the Eucharist, i.e. that the bread and wine truly become the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ? Do we believe that God loves each one of us? Do we believe in our baptismal call to serve God and one another? Believing can be approached from so many directions. Regardless of where you start, it is important to start and keep going. The quantity and depth of our beliefs will grow over time if we let them.

Lent is an ideal time to help on this "belief" quest. Merely participating in the Lenten celebrations and, in particular, joining us for the celebrations of Holy Week will assist you in growing in the faith. The days of Holy Week contain the prime components of our set of beliefs. Taking advantage of the videos and programs on Formed that explain our faith or invite you to reflect upon our faith would be helpful. Spending time before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament during our adoration times strengthens one's beliefs. Reading the writings of your favourite saint can deepen your beliefs. Or it can be as simple as just asking God like one of the characters in Mark's gospel, "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief".

Dans l'Évangile de cette fin de semaine, Jésus demande à l'aveugle : « Crois-tu au Fils de l'homme ? » La foi semble être un concept clé pour Jésus. Selon lui, croire nous aide à éviter la condamnation, croire mène à la vie éternelle, tandis que ne pas croire conduit à la condamnation et à la perte. Nous nous qualifions souvent de croyants. Chaque semaine, nous récitons le credo où nous proclamons avec assurance « Je crois » à plusieurs reprises. Mais en quoi croyons-nous ? Croyons-nous que Jésus est le Fils de Dieu, qu'il est mort, a été enseveli et est ressuscité des morts ? Croyons-nous au Père et au Saint-Esprit ? Croyons-nous à la présence réelle dans l'Eucharistie, c'est-à-dire que le pain et le vin deviennent véritablement le Corps et le Sang, l'Âme et la Divinité du Christ ? Croyons-nous que Dieu aime chacun d'entre nous ? Croyons-nous en notre appel baptismal à servir Dieu et à nous servir les uns les autres ? La foi peut être abordée sous de nombreux angles. Peu importe par où vous commencez, l'important est de commencer et de persévérer. La quantité et la profondeur de nos croyances grandiront avec le temps si nous les laissons s'épanouir.

Solemnity of St. Joseph

This Thursday we will be celebrating the Solemnity of St. Joseph. It is unusual for us to be celebrating a solemnity during the week, especially during Lent. However, St. Joseph is Patron of the Universal Church and Principal Patron of Canada. He is also the patron of the dying, the patron of fathers, of carpenters, and of social justice. St. Joseph was the Spouse of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, and therefore St. Joseph is the foster-father of Jesus. St. Joseph is also the Heir of David, being descended after many generations from King David through the kings of Judah and their descendants, as the one through whom God's promises to David would be fulfilled. St. Joseph was known as a righteous man, who was upright and just in all of his works and deeds, in all of his ways and in his obedience to God. St. Joseph did not exercise a very public role, but faithfully, and often quietly, fulfilled his duty to care and provide for Mary and Jesus. Let us be inspired to follow the example and selfless dedication of St. Joseph!

Cependant, saint Joseph est le patron de l'Église universelle et le patron principal du Canada. Il est également le patron des mourants, des pères, des charpentiers et de la justice sociale. Saint Joseph était l'époux de Marie, la Sainte Mère de Dieu, et donc le père adoptif de Jésus. Saint Joseph est également l'héritier de David, descendant après de nombreuses générations du roi David par les rois de Juda et leurs descendants, comme celui par qui les promesses de Dieu à David seraient accomplies. Saint Joseph était connu comme un homme juste, droit et honnête dans toutes ses œuvres et ses actions, dans toutes ses voies et dans son obéissance à Dieu. Saint Joseph n'a pas exercé un rôle très public, mais il a fidèlement, et souvent discrètement, rempli son devoir de prendre soin de Marie et de Jésus et de subvenir à leurs besoins. 
