## From the Pastor's Pen ~

### Sunday Reflection

In this weekend's psalm we hear, "With the Lord there is steadfast love and great power to redeem." The overall theme of Lent always has a penitential tone. We are invited to look at our sinful ways and commit to trying to do better. A key part of that is taking a serious step back and reflecting upon our past words and actions. Have they been instances of sharing God's love? Have we disrespected or mistreated God, others or ourselves? Each time we fail to act in a loving way we venture into sinful territory. The devil is constantly trying to lure us down the road of selfishness and indifference. We need to battle against that. However, that is not easy to do. What makes it even harder is that through our sin we are weakened. Each time we sin, we lose a little of our spiritual strength, making us even more likely to sin again. This creates a downward spiral that we are unable to stop on our own.

Thus, we proclaim, "With the Lord there is steadfast love and great power to redeem." We need God's help to break our pattern of sin. We need God to remove the burden that sin adds to our lives and to free us to love like him. Only God can wipe away our transgressions and cleanse our lives. Through the loving cleansing He offers us He adds the polishing of grace to protect us from evil. Sadly, over time, that polishing gets exposed to new dirt (temptations) that we give in to, thus we become spiritually dirty once more.

This is why we are so blessed to be able to go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation so often. The cycle of needing cleansing keeps repeating itself. God (through the priest) does not condemn in the sacrament, but rather gently shares love, mercy and forgiveness.

### Réflexion du dimanche

Dans le psaume de cette fin de semaine, nous entendons : « Chez le Seigneur se trouvent l'amour fidèle et une grande puissance de rédemption. » Le thème général du Carême revêt toujours un caractère pénitentiel. Nous sommes invités à examiner nos comportements pécheresses et à nous engager à faire mieux. Pour cela, il est essentiel de prendre sérieusement du recul et de réfléchir à nos paroles et à nos actes passés. Y a-t-il eu des moments où nous avons partagé l'amour de Dieu ? Avons-nous manqué de respect ou maltraité Dieu, les autres ou nous-mêmes ? Chaque fois que nous manquons d'agir avec amour, nous nous aventurons sur le terrain du péché. Le diable tente constamment de nous entraîner sur la voie de l'égoïsme et de l'indifférence. Nous devons lutter contre cela. Cependant, ce n'est pas facile. Ce qui rend la tâche encore plus difficile, c'est que nos péchés nous affaiblissent. Chaque fois que nous péchons, nous perdons un peu de notre force spirituelle, ce qui nous rend encore plus enclins à pécher à nouveau. Cela crée une spirale descendante que nous sommes incapables d'arrêter par nous-mêmes.

C'est pourquoi nous proclamons : « Chez le Seigneur se trouvent l'amour inébranlable et la grande puissance de la rédemption. » Nous avons besoin de l'aide de Dieu pour briser notre cycle de péché. Nous avons besoin que Dieu enlève le fardeau que le péché ajoute à nos vies et qu'il nous libère pour aimer comme lui. *...suite à la page 2*

Plenty of opportunity this week (see the reconciliation schedule) to get yourself back on the "love path"!

**Diocesan Day of Confession**

On our annual Diocesan Day of Confessions, every church across the Diocese will be open and have priests available to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This is a unique opportunity to encounter the Lord through his ministers and to experience his unconditional acceptance and limitless mercy—to know directly the healing power of his love.

Perhaps it has been some time since you shared in this sacrament. Nevertheless, the door is always open, the Lord is always waiting to receive and to forgive. And as Jesus said so often: "Do not be afraid." For all of us, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is the opportunity to be set free from all that encumbers us in mind, heart and spirit. Seul Dieu peut effacer nos transgressions et purifier nos vies. Par la purification d'amour qu'Il nous offre, Il ajoute le polissage de la grâce pour nous protéger du mal. Malheureusement, avec le temps, ce polissage est exposé à une nouvelle saleté (les tentations) à laquelle nous cédon, et nous devenons ainsi à nouveau spirituellement souillés. C'est pourquoi nous avons la grande chance de pouvoir nous rendre si souvent au sacrement de la Réconciliation. Le cycle du besoin de purification ne cesse de se répéter. Dieu (par l'intermédiaire du prêtre) ne condamne pas dans le sacrement, mais partage plutôt avec douceur l'amour, la miséricorde et le pardon. Dieu nous libère du poids du péché pour nous permettre de mieux aimer Dieu, nous-mêmes et les autres. Le péché mène à un cœur rempli de haine, la pureté avec Dieu mène à un cœur rempli d'amour. Quand on ne profite pas de l'occasion d'effacer son péché, devinez ce que l'on devient ? Ne pensez-vous pas que nous avons besoin de plus d'« aimants » que de « haineux » dans le monde ? Cette semaine, de nombreuses occasions s'offrent à vous (voir le calendrier des confessions) pour vous remettre sur le « chemin de l'amour » !

**Journée diocésaine de la confession**

À l'occasion de notre Journée diocésaine annuelle de la confession, toutes les églises du diocèse seront ouvertes et des prêtres seront disponibles pour célébrer le sacrement de la réconciliation. C'est une occasion unique de rencontrer le Seigneur à travers ses ministres et de faire l'expérience de son acceptation inconditionnelle et de sa miséricorde sans limites — de connaître directement le pouvoir guérisseur de son amour.

Peut-être cela fait-il quelque temps que vous n'avez pas reçu ce sacrement. Néanmoins, la porte est toujours ouverte, le Seigneur attend toujours pour vous accueillir et vous pardonner. Et comme Jésus l'a si souvent dit : « N'ayez pas peur. » Pour nous tous, le sacrement de la réconciliation est l'occasion d'être libérés de tout ce qui nous encombre l'esprit, le cœur et l'âme. Participez à la prochaine Journée des confessions et répondez à l'invitation du Seigneur à sortir des ténèbres du péché et à vivre le don de la vie nouvelle qu'il nous offre.


