## From the Pastor's Pen ~

### Holy Week

This week we enter into the holiest time of the year. The priests of our diocese are going to gather with the Bishop for an afternoon of reflection on Monday. This will be followed by the Mass of Chrism where the priests renew their priestly promises and the Bishop will bless all the oils to be used for the sacraments for the coming year. Thursday will be our Holy Thursday celebrations where we celebrate the institution of the sacramental priesthood and the institution of the Eucharist. The Masses will be followed by a time of adoration in the "Chapel of Repose".

We will have six Good Friday services. The two morning services will be adapted slightly to better accommodate families (i.e. one fewer reading and modified solemn intercessions. There will not be any drama presentations). All of our Good Friday services will include the distribution of Communion. Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Drinking water, tea, juices, etc. do not constitute breaking the fast. As well, people are encouraged to take their normal medications.

## De la plume du curé ~

### Semaine Sainte

Cette semaine, nous entrons dans la période la plus sacrée de l'année. Les prêtres de notre diocèse se réuniront avec l'évêque lundi après-midi pour un moment de réflexion. Cette rencontre sera suivie par la messe chrysmale, au cours de laquelle les prêtres renouvelleront leurs promesses sacerdotales et l'évêque bénira toutes les huiles qui seront utilisées pour les sacrements au cours de l'année à venir. Jeudi, nous célébrerons le Jeudi Saint, où nous commémorerons l'institution du sacerdoce sacramentel et l'institution de l'Eucharistie. Les messes seront suivies d'un temps d'adoration dans la « chapelle du repos ».

Nous aurons six services le Vendredi Saint. Les deux services du matin seront légèrement adaptés pour mieux accueillir les familles (c'est-à-dire une lecture en moins et des intercessions solennelles modifiées. Il n'y aura pas de représentations théâtrales). Tous nos services du Vendredi Saint comprendront la distribution de la communion. Le Vendredi Saint est un jour de jeûne et d'abstinence. Pour les membres de l'Église catholique latine, les normes relatives au jeûne sont obligatoires de 18 à 59 ans. Pendant le jeûne, une personne est autorisée à prendre un repas complet. Deux repas plus légers peuvent également être pris, mais sans totaliser l'équivalent d'un repas complet. Les normes concernant l'abstinence de viande s'imposent aux membres de l'Église catholique latine à partir de 14 ans. Boire de l'eau, du thé, des jus de fruits, etc. ne constitue pas une rupture du jeûne. De même, les fidèles sont encouragés à prendre leurs médicaments habituels.

The Easter Vigil will be celebrated at three of our parish sites and is THE celebration of our liturgical year. Although it is a lengthy celebration [probably 2+ hours] its richness and meaning is unsurpassed. We are blessed to have a number baptisms and receptions into full communion this year. Our Easter Sunday Masses follow our normal Sunday schedule with the addition of a French Mass at 7:30am at Ste. Anne's.

Incense will be used at the end of the Holy Thursday Mass and during the Easter Vigil Mass, but will not be used at any of the other Triduum celebrations.

We will be following the liturgical guidelines of the Church, so please note that there will not be any Mass Holy Thursday morning, Good Friday, nor Holy Saturday morning. As well, there will not be any confession times Holy Thursday, Good Friday, nor Holy Saturday morning.

**Divine Mercy Sunday**

The Sunday after Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday. We have a very merciful God who wants to share with us his gift of mercy/forgiveness. As Jesus said to St. Faustina, "I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My Mercy". The Feast of Divine Mercy is based upon the devotion to Divine Mercy that St. Faustina Kowalska (a Polish nun and saint) reported as part of her encounter with Jesus, and is associated with special promises from Jesus and plenary indulgences declared by the Church. Our Family of Parishes will be celebrating a Divine Mercy Sunday Prayer Service at Ste. Anne's, April 12th at 3:00pm. Confessions will be available beginning at 2:00pm.

Comme Jésus l'a dit à sainte Faustine : « Je veux accorder un pardon complet aux âmes qui se confesseront et recevront la Sainte Communion lors de la Fête de Ma Miséricorde ». La Fête de la Miséricorde divine trouve son origine dans la dévotion à la Miséricorde divine dont sainte Faustine Kowalska (une religieuse et sainte polonaise) a fait état dans le cadre de sa rencontre avec Jésus, et elle est associée à des promesses spéciales de Jésus et à des indulgences plénières déclarées par l'Église. Notre famille de paroisses célébrera un service de prière du dimanche de la Miséricorde divine à Sainte-Anne, le 12 avril à 15 h. Les confessions seront disponibles à partir de 14 h.


