From the Pastor's Pen ~

Sunday Reflection

The 3rd Sunday of Lent reminds us that God is with us, even when we are tired, unsure, or in need. Each reading shows people who feel empty or thirsty, but God gives them what they truly need. He does not leave them alone. He hears their cries and responds with love and care.

In Exodus, the people are in the desert. They have no water and feel afraid. But God tells Moses to strike the rock, and water flows out. God provides, even when they doubt Him. This shows how God stays close, even when we struggle to believe.

The Gospel reading tells the story of the Samaritan woman at the well. Jesus talks with her and offers something much greater than regular water. He gives her hope, truth, and new life. She leaves changed, ready to share what she has found.

These readings help us look at our own lives. Where are we empty? What are we really looking for? Lent is a time to open our hearts to Jesus, the one who gives us living water. (excerpt from young-catholics.com)

Réflexion du dimanche

Le troisième dimanche de Carême nous rappelle que Dieu est avec nous, même lorsque nous sommes fatigués, incertains ou dans le besoin. Chaque lecture montre des personnes qui se sentent vides ou assoiffées, mais Dieu leur donne ce dont elles ont vraiment besoin. Il ne les abandonne pas. Il entend leurs cris et répond avec amour et attention.

Dans l'Exode, le peuple se trouve dans le désert. Ils n'ont pas d'eau et ont peur. Mais Dieu dit à Moïse de frapper le rocher, et l'eau jaillit. Dieu pourvoit à leurs besoins, même lorsqu'ils doutent de lui. Cela montre à quel point Dieu reste proche, même lorsque nous avons du mal à croire.

La lecture de l'Évangile raconte l'histoire de la Samaritaine au puits. Jésus lui parle et lui offre quelque chose de bien plus grand que de l'eau ordinaire. Il lui donne l'espoir, la vérité et une nouvelle vie. Elle repart transformée, prête à partager ce qu'elle a trouvé.

Ces lectures nous aident à examiner notre propre vie. Où sommes-nous vides ? Que recherchons-nous vraiment ? Le Carême est un temps pour ouvrir notre cœur à Jésus, celui qui nous donne l'eau vive. (extrait de young-catholics.com)

Cornerstone Weekend

Please pray for the Cornerstone Team and youth participants on the Cornerstone Retreat this weekend. Just as we hear the story of the Samaritan women in today's gospel encountering Jesus and having her life changed, may those on this weekend encounter Christ in a new way and have their lives changed.

Palms

Each year you may wonder what you should do with your "used" palm branches. You can burn them or bury them in your garden. Or perhaps you can return them to the church and we will burn them to create the ashes for next year's Ash Wednesday. Each church has a place that you can drop off the palms from last year in the entrance area.

Diocesan Day of Confession

On our annual Diocesan Day of Confessions, every church across the Diocese will be open and have priests available to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This is a unique opportunity to encounter the Lord through his ministers and to experience his unconditional acceptance and limitless mercy—to know directly the healing power of his love.

Perhaps it has been some time since you shared in this sacrament. Nevertheless, the door is always open, the Lord is always waiting to receive and to forgive. And as Jesus said so often: "Do not be afraid." For all of us, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is the opportunity to be set free from all that encumbers us in mind, heart and spirit. Share in the upcoming Day of Confessions and answer the Lord's invitation to come out of the darkness of sin and to live the gift of new which life he offers.

Rameaux

Vous pouvez aussi les rapporter à l'église et nous les brûlerons pour créer les cendres du mercredi des Cendres de l'année prochaine. Chaque église dispose d'un endroit où vous pouvez déposer les palmes de l'année dernière dans l'entrée.
