



Ginny's eyes lit up with joy. I'm so excited for her and for all of our young people who have received their sacraments this year. Besides Ginny receiving her First Communion, my nephew, Joseph, received his Confirmation a few weeks ago, and my youngest niece, Clara, received her first Reconciliation (or "the day my sins were wiped away," as she put it).
