## The Role of Mary

Mary's role in the wedding at Cana is highlighted in the Gospel reading for the 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C. She notices that the wine has run out and asks Jesus to help. Her faith and care for others are evident in her actions.

Mary's request to Jesus shows her trust in His ability to help. She serves as an example of faith and intercession. Just as she asked Jesus to help at the wedding, we can ask her to intercede for us with her Son.

Reflecting on Mary's role can inspire us to have faith and trust in Jesus. We should follow her example by bringing our needs to Jesus and believing in His power to help. Mary's care and faith remind us to turn to Jesus in times of need...which is the focus of the Memorare.

In youth ministry, the Memorare can help young people connect with Mary as a role model and friend. It shows that we can go to her with our needs, trusting in her care. Mary's example of humility and trust encourages youth to grow in faith and courage, even in difficult times. The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains this, saying, "In a wholly singular way she cooperated by her obedience, faith, hope, and burning charity in the Savior's work of restoring supernatural life to souls" (CCC 968). By praying the Memorare, young people learn to see Mary as a strong, loving guide in their journey toward God.

### The Memorare Prayer

*Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your help, or sought your intercession, was left unaided.*

*Inspired by this confidence,*

*I fly unto you, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother.*

*To you do I come, before you I stand, sinful and sorrowful.*

*O Mother of the Word Incarnate,*

*despise not my petitions,*

*but in your mercy, hear and answer me.*

*Amen.*

## Le rôle de Marie

Le rôle de Marie aux noces de Cana est mis en lumière dans la lecture de l'Évangile du deuxième dimanche du temps ordinaire de l'année C. Elle remarque que le vin est épuisé et demande à Jésus de l'aider. Sa foi et son souci des autres sont évidents dans ses actions.

La demande de Marie à Jésus montre qu'elle a confiance en sa capacité à l'aider. Elle est un exemple de foi et d'intercession. Tout comme elle a demandé à Jésus de l'aider aux noces, nous pouvons lui demander d'intercéder pour nous auprès de son Fils.

Réfléchir au rôle de Marie peut nous inspirer la foi et la confiance en Jésus. Nous devrions suivre son exemple en faisant part de nos besoins à Jésus et en croyant en son pouvoir de nous aider. L'attention et la foi de Marie nous rappellent de nous tourner vers Jésus en cas de besoin... ce qui est l'objectif du Memorare.

Dans le cadre de la pastorale des jeunes, le Memorare peut aider les jeunes à se rapprocher de Marie en tant que modèle et amie. Il montre que nous pouvons aller la voir pour lui faire part de nos besoins, en ayant confiance en ses soins. L'exemple d'humilité et de confiance de Marie encourage les jeunes à grandir dans la foi et le courage, même dans les moments difficiles. Le Catéchisme de l'Église Catholique l'explique en disant : « D'une manière tout à fait singulière, elle a coopéré par son obéissance, sa foi, son espérance et son ardente charité à l'œuvre du Sauveur qui consiste à rendre aux âmes la vie surnaturelle » (CEC 968). En priant le Memorare, les jeunes apprennent à voir Marie comme une guide forte et aimante dans leur voyage vers Dieu.

### Le Memorare

*Souvenez-vous, ô très miséricordieuse Vierge Marie, qu'on n'a jamais entendu dire qu'aucun de ceux qui avaient eu recours à votre protection, imploré votre assistance, réclamé votre secours, ait été abandonné.*

*Animé d'une pareille confiance,*

*ô Vierge des vierges, ô ma Mère, je cours vers vous*

*et, gémissant sous le poids de mes péchés,*

*je me prosterne à vos pieds.*

*Ô Mère du Verbe, ne méprisez pas mes prières,*

*mais accueillez-les favorablement et daignez les exaucer.*

*Amen*



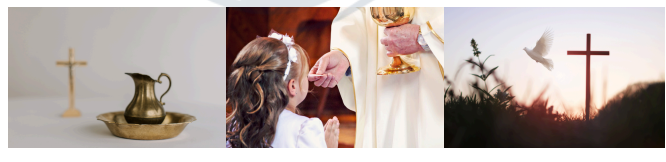

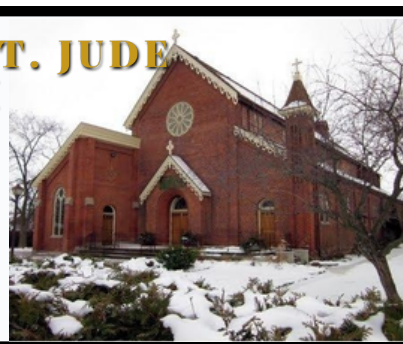

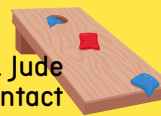
