


Diocesan Services Appeal St. Lucie Parish Goal: \$207,000

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT - every Thursday and First Friday of the Month

A consecrated host, the Holy Eucharist, is placed in a special container attached within a standing cross called a "Monstrance." The Holy Eucharist is Jesus Christ and although it does not look like the body and blood of Jesus, His Real Presence is hidden within the appearance of the consecrated host. This is a great mystery, something we are not capable of fully understanding, but we know it to be truth. People come in reverence to pray before the Sacrament. At Saint Lucie Parish, we have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament every Thursday and every First Friday of the Month in the church after the 8:00 AM. Mass, and this continues until 5:00 PM ending with Benediction on Thursdays and First Friday. There is a sign-up sheet for those desiring to commit themselves in prayer and in presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Usually, we sign our names for an hour designating that we will be present. This is done never to have Jesus left alone! Come, join us and spend quality time with our Lord.

Origins of The Feast of Corpus Christi

In the year 1263, a German priest, Peter of Prague, stopped at the town of Bolsena, north of Rome, while he was on a pilgrimage to Rome. Records indicate that Peter was a good, pious priest who strived for holiness. He was troubled by the apathy of many of the faithful; clerical immorality and laxity; and a lack of reverence at Mass. Worse, he was afflicted with doubt about the holy Eucharist. Like those in the Gospel, he asked himself, "How could this be? How can Jesus share with us His Body and Blood?" He agonized over whether at the words of consecration the bread and wine became the Body and Blood of Our Savior and whether Christ actually was present in the consecrated host. He knew well that the church believed and taught that the bread and wine were transformed into the Body and Blood of Our Lord at the consecration during the holy sacrifice of the Mass. Moreover, the Fourth Lateran Council in 1215 had solemnly used the word "transubstantiation." Yet, he had trouble believing and prayed that the Lord would increase his faith.

The next day, he celebrated Mass at the tomb of St. Christina, an early martyr of the church. As soon as he said the words of consecration, the host began to bleed. Blood fell onto his hands and onto the corporal [linen] on the altar. He was awestruck and began to cry. At first, he was not sure what to do and tried to hide the blood, but then interrupted the Mass and announced what had happened. The congregation, too, was awestruck. He asked to be taken to see Pope Urban IV who was residing at the neighboring town of Orvieto about 10 miles away.

Father Peter placed the host in the corporal and then wrapped both in another linen. Arriving at Orvieto, Peter told the Holy Father what had happened. Urban IV then ordered an investigation. After all of the facts had been ascertained, the Holy Father declared a miracle had occurred. He ordered the relics to be brought to the Cathedral of Orvieto, which they were with a procession of great pomp and ceremony. The pope met the procession, and the relics were placed in the cathedral, where they are still be venerated today.

One year later, in 1264, Pope Urban IV instituted the feast of Corpus Christi, a special feast day to recognize and to promote the great gift of the Blessed Sacrament. He commissioned St. Thomas Aquinas to compose a Mass and an office for the Liturgy of the Hours honoring the holy Eucharist. St. Thomas Aquinas also composed the beautiful Eucharistic hymns "Panis



Angelicus," "Pange Lingua," "O Salutaris Hostia" and "Tantum Ergo."

Today, at the Church of St. Christina in Bolsena, one finds the altar where the miracle took place, and the blood-stained stones of the miracle are preserved. The Cathedral of Orvieto possesses the blood-stained corporal as well as fragments of the miraculous host.

CORPUS CHRISTI

(Fuente: EWTN—Acoirensa)

La Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, como también es conocida esta celebración, tiene su origen en un milagro eucarístico del s. XIII. En ella, la Iglesia Católica tributa a la Eucaristía -presencia real de Cristo- culto público y solemne de adoración, amor y gratitud. En con-



secuencia, la procesión del Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo que se realiza después de la Misa principal del día es la más importante de todas las procesiones.

Origen de la celebración del Corpus Christi

A mediados del siglo XIII, Pedro de Praga, sacerdote que dudaba de la presencia real de Cristo en la Eucaristía, realizó una peregrinación a la ciudad de Roma para pedir sobre la tumba de San Pedro una gracia especial. A su retorno a Bolsena, mientras celebraba la Santa Misa en la Cripta de Santa Cristina, se percató de que había un rastro de sangre sobre el corporal (paño litúrgico de color blanco que se coloca sobre el altar) cuya fuente era la forma u hostia consagrada que tenía en sus manos.

La noticia llegó rápidamente a oídos del Papa Urbano IV, quien se encontraba cerca de la Cripta, en Orvieto. Pronto el Pontífice mandó que el corporal sea llevado a su presencia. Una vez que lo tuvo frente a sí, lo contempló maravillado.

El Papa entendió que se trataba de un milagro auténtico, con un mensaje claro: los fieles han de fortalecer su fe y amor a la Eucaristía. Entonces, publica la bula "Transiturus", en la que quedó establecida la celebración del Corpus Christi para la Iglesia universal todos los jueves después del domingo de la Santísima Trinidad.

Participación de Santo Tomás de Aquino

El Papa, además, encomendó a Santo Tomás de Aquino la preparación del oficio litúrgico propio del día y la composición de himnos para la Misa. Por su belleza y profundidad, dos de esas composiciones han quedado asociadas para siempre al Corpus Christi: Los Himnos Tantum Ergo y el Lauda Sion Salvatorem. Posteriormente, el Papa Clemente V, durante el Concilio general de Viena (1311), confirmó la importancia de la celebración del Corpus Christi y publicó un nuevo decreto pontificio, en el que la bula de Urbano IV estuvo incorporada. Luego, el Papa Juan XXII (1316-1334) instó a la observancia de la fecha.


