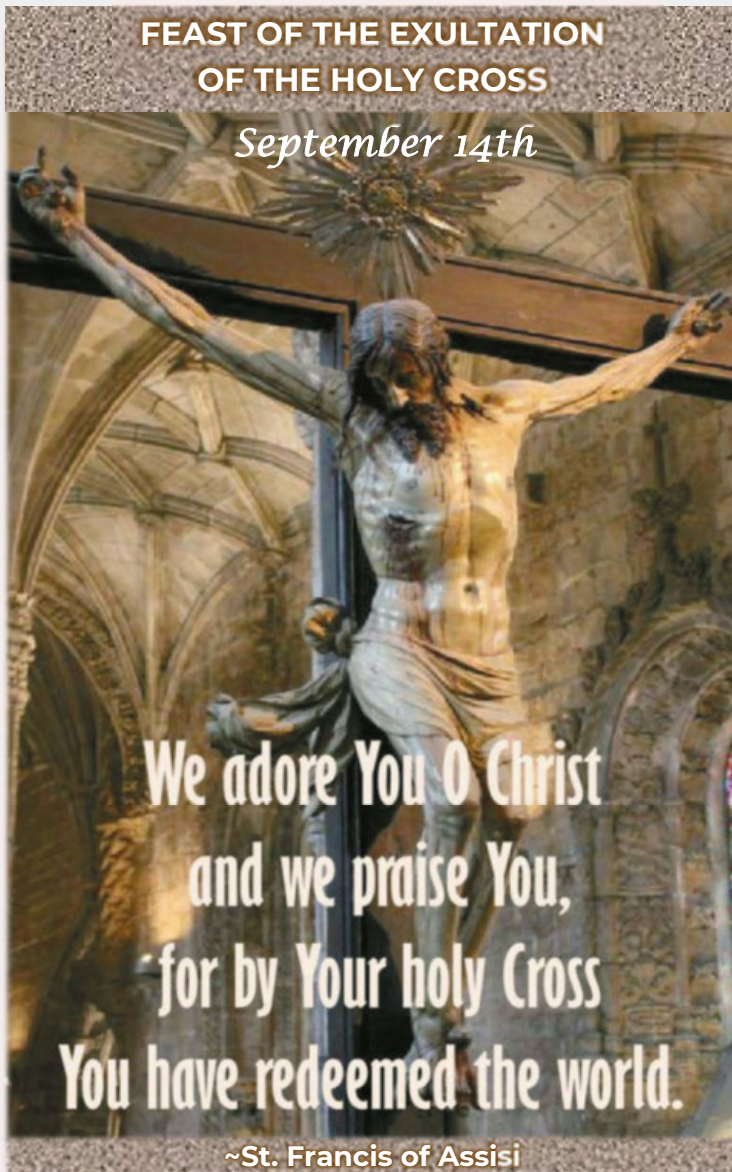

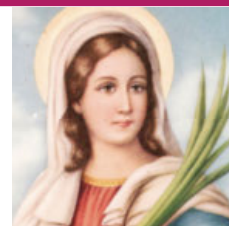



St. John Chrysostom

Early Church Father, biblical interpreter, and archbishop of Constantinople.. Died Sept. 13, 407

St. John was brought to Constantinople after a dozen years of priestly service as an ascetic monk in Syria. His lifestyle at the imperial court was not appreciated by many courtiers. He offered a modest table to episcopal sycophants hanging around for imperial and ecclesiastical favors.

He was called 'golden-mouth' due to his beautiful homilies. He is known to have fed up to 3,000 of the poor daily. His zeal led him to decisive action. Bishops who bribed their way into office were deposed. Many of his sermons called for concrete steps to share wealth with the poor. The rich did not appreciate hearing from John that private property existed because of Adam's fall from grace any more than married men liked to hear that they were bound to marital fidelity just as much as their wives were. When it came to justice and charity, John acknowledged no double standards. The Emperor and Empress of Alexandria resented his sermons contrasting gospel values with the excesses of imperial court life,. They finally did manage to have John exiled. He died in exile in 407.

Permaneció treinta años en el convento de
Tolentino dedicado a visitar a los enfermos,
consolar a los afligidos y socorrer a los pobres.

Declaró que en una ocasión, hallándose
gravemente enfermo, tuvo una visión de la
Virgen María que le daba de comer unos
bocados de pan, con lo que quedó
repentinamente sano. En memoria de ello, se
bendicen en el día de su festividad unos
panecillos llamados «de San Nicolás».

Se le atribuyen más de 300 milagros,
acontecidos tanto en vida como post mortem.

La iglesia católica conmemora este santo el 10
de septiembre. Fue canonizado el 1o. De
febrero de 1447 por el Papa Eugenio IV.

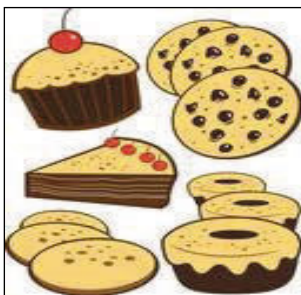

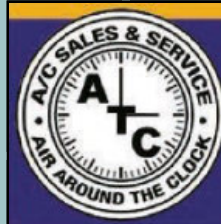

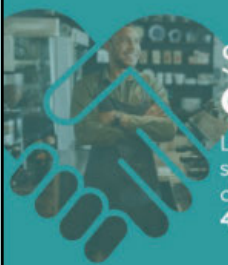
