DO YOU KNOW WHERE YOUR CHARITABLE GIVING GOES?

This year alone our Parish donated money to many charities within our boundaries. Your generosity is going a long way to support your parish

and the needy in and around our parish community. Thank you!

We know that it must seem like we are always asking for money, and that is true. Why, you may ask? Our expenses are increasing, just as yours are at home. We would love not having to worry about money, but as you can see from the included financial report, our income is not keeping pace with our expenses. In order to keep our church running (Insurance, payroll, benefits, electric, water, extensive repairs to our dear OLD parish facilities ((FYI: did you know that we have 25 A/C handlers that need almost constant upkeep and repair?)), communications, Religious Education costs, etc.) It costs money. A <u>lot</u> of money. Please consider these factors when filling out your offertory envelopes. See below for a great way to give and get a tax break if you are a retiree:

STRATEGIC GIVING FOR RETIREES

Those of you over 70 $\frac{1}{2}$, who are blessed with an IRA, know about RMD's (Required Minimum Distribution). Here is a suggestion of what to do with that RMD if you wish to increase your charitable giving and save on the taxes that distribution entails. It's called a Qualified Charitable Distribution or QCD, available to those over 70 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Here are the basics: You may distribute any portion of your RMD, up to \$100,000.00 per year.

This QCD is not taxable to either you or the charity you choose, St. Lucie Catholic Church, for example. Thus the QCD will reduce your taxes.

Should you wish to participate in a QCD, contact your IRA custodian for the appropriate forms. One final note: You can also name St. Lucie Catholic Church as a partial or full beneficiary of your IRA. In that way, all or part of those IRA assets will support St. Lucie. If left to charity, there are no taxes assessed. Make sure your IRA custodian identifies you when making any donation.

THE PRESENTATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY. November 21st

The Protoevangelium of James tells us that Anna and Joachim offered Mary to God in the Temple when she was 3 years old. This was to carry out a promise made to God when Anna was still childless.

Though it cannot be proven historically, Mary's presentation has an important theological purpose. It continues the impact of the feasts of the Immaculate Conception and of the birth of Mary. It emphasizes that holiness was conferred on Mary from the beginning of her life.

Reflection

Even though the feast has no basis in history, it stresses an important truth about Mary: From the beginning of her life, she was dedicated to God. She herself became a greater temple than any made by hands. God came to dwell in her in a marvelous manner and sanctified her for her unique role in God's saving work. At the same time, the magnificence of Mary enriches her children. They—we—too are temples of God and sanctified in order that we might enjoy and share in God's saving work. franciscanmedia.org


