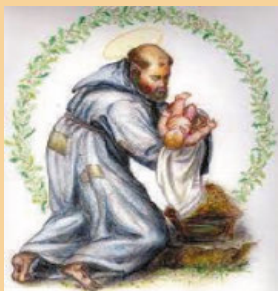

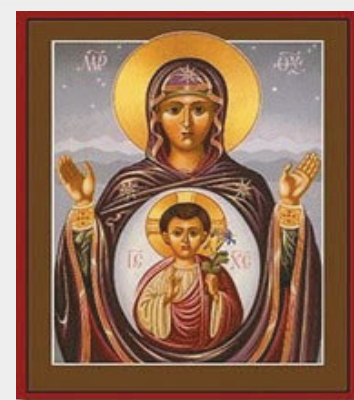

Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God. January 1

The title "Mother of God" goes back to the third or fourth century, but the Greek term **Theotokos** ("The God-bearer") was officially consecrated as Catholic doctrine at the Council of Ephesus in 431, thus becoming the first Marian dogma. At the end of the Council of Ephesus, crowds of people marched through the streets shouting: "Honor be to Theotokos!"

In its chapter on Mary's role in the Church, Vatican II's Dogmatic Constitution "Lumen Gentium" ("Light of the People") calls Mary "Mother of God" 12 times.

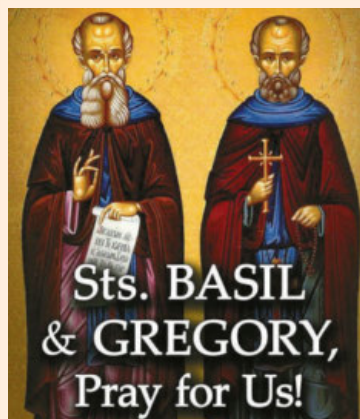

Sts. Basil the Great and Gregory Nazianzen Bishops and Doctors January 2

Sts. Basil and Gregory were childhood friends who both came from saintly families. They grew up to defend the Trinity and Jesus'

divinity at a crucial time in the development of the Church's understanding of these mysteries.

Basil was born in 330 as one of 10 children to a noble family in what is now Turkey. Both of his parents were saints (and four of his siblings became saints as well. Even his grandmother was a saint!

As a young man, Basil was known for organizing food relief for those suffering from famine. He became famous for his rhetorical skills but was tempted by pride because of it. He responded by selling all he owned to become a priest and monk.

He founded a monastery and wrote down instructions on community life, which have become famous and especially important in guiding religious communities in the east. He continued to found monasteries and was ordained bishop of Caesarea (in modern Israel) in 370, where he led for seven years until his death.

From his youth, Basil was friends with Gregory Nazianzen, another brilliant thinker and orator. Gregory also had saintly parents and two of his siblings also became saints.

Gregory followed a similar career path as Basil and was ordained a bishop by him. He made major contributions in the way the mystery of the Trinity.

Basil and Gregory were defining figures as the early Church sought to figure out just how to describe Jesus as fully human and fully divine. Their doctrinal contributions are codified in the Nicene Creed we recite at Mass.

Both Basil and Gregory were declared doctors of the Church, a title given to 36 saints who are known for elucidating the faith by their words or example.

EL "SÍ" DE MARIA

Cuando pensamos en el "Sí" de María a la propuesta de Dios, lo podemos imaginar en un ambiente casi de novela "romántica", y olvidar que con ese "Sí", toda su vida quedó comprometida. La respuesta que ella dio no era algo espontáneo o "lógico". María dirá que sí, más por confianza y fe, que por conocimiento. Ella apenas podía entender lo que le había sido explicado...y sin embargo, dice que "Sí". Además, la fe de María será puesta a prueba cada día. Ella quedará encinta. No sabe bien cómo, pero lo cierto es que su corazón está inundado por una luz especial. Aunque su querido José dude, ella vive inmersa en el misterio sin pedir pruebas, vive unida al misterio más radical que existe: Dios. Él sabrá encontrar las soluciones a todos los problemas, pero hacía falta fe, hacía falta abandono total a su voluntad.



María se dejó guiar por la fe. Ésta la llevó a creer a pesar de que parecía imposible lo anunciado. El Misterio se encarnó en ella de la manera más radical que se podía imaginar. Sin certezas humanas, ella supo acoger confiadamente la palabra de Dios. María también supo esperar, ¿cómo vivió María aquellos meses, y las últimas semanas en la espera de su Hijo? Sólo por medio de la oración y de la unión con Dios podemos hacernos una pálida idea de lo que ella vivió en su interior. También María vivió con intensidad ese acontecimiento que transformó toda su existencia de manera radical. Ella dijo "Sí" y engendró físicamente al Hijo de Dios, al que ya había concebido desde la fe. Estas son experiencias que contrastan con nuestro mundo materialista, especialmente en la cercanía de las fiestas de Navidad. Por ello, como cristianos, ¿cómo no centrar más nuestra vida al contemplar este Misterio inefable? ¿Cómo no dar el anuncio de la alegría de la Navidad a todos los que no han experimentado ese Dios-Amor?

No olvidemos que un día ese Dios creció en el seno de María, y también puede crecer hoy en nuestros corazones, si por la fe creemos, y si en la espera sabemos dar sentido a toda nuestra vida mirando con valor al futuro.

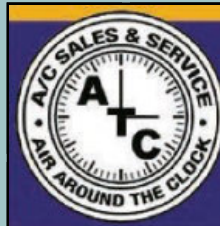
