#### **Present Families:**

Re-Enrollment is now open for the 2023 - 2024 school year. Seats are limited so reserve now!

  - a. \$200 deposit toward next year's tuition for PreK 8 (non-refundable)
  - b. Register new siblings paperwork is due to the office
  - c. \$35 fee for Blackbaud tuition process

Enrollment in Blackbaud must be completed by Friday, February 10. A non-refundable late fee of \$100 will be applied if the date is missed. (If you will need an extension, write a note to Sister Lisa.) To enroll you must be current on your tuition payments.

2. Special note: everyone will be presumed to be returning for the 2023 – 2024 school year unless the opt-out form is completed and returned by February 13th.
