EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

January 6, 2019 YEAR C

* REFLECTION *

Behold, the Lord, the Mighty One, has come;
on this day God revealed to the nations his Only
Begotten Son by the guidance of a star. This is the
King of all nations and the only Lord, promised
through God for those, who believed in the Be-
gotten Son of the Father before the daystar shone
or time – began.

The star burns like a flame, pointing the way
to God, the King of kings; the wise men saw the
sign and brought their gifts in homage to their
great King. Seeing the star, the wise men said:
“This must signify the birth of some great king. Let
us search for him and lay our treasures at his feet:
gold, frankincense and myrrh”. They carry their
gifts and their hearts are thrilled and rejoice pro-
claiming the praise of the Lord. They give praise to
God and the Church professes: “**Lord, every na-
tion on earth will adore you**”, because the heav-
ens proclaim the justice of God and all nations see
his glory.

Isaiah's calling comes back: “Arise! Shine!
Shine the Church, for your light has come. “**This is
the glorious day on which Christ himself, the Sav-
ior of the world, appeared; the prophets foretold
of him, the angels worship him; The Magi saw his
star and rejoiced to lay their treasures at his feet.
God's holy day has dawned for us at last; Come,
all you peoples, and adore the Lord**”.

By revelation the mystery was made known
to us... that the gentiles have become fellow
heirs, members of the same body, and sharers in
the promise in Christ Jesus.

“Today the Bridegroom claims his bride, the Church, since Christ has washed her sins away in Jordan’s waters; the Magi hasten with their gifts to the royal wedding; and the wedding guests rejoice, for Christ has changed water into wine”. This mystery, which has been hidden through all ages and from all generations, is revealed to us today. Christ Jesus has come, share the joyful news: Peace for the people of good will. He was seen on earth and he was a man among men. He established the faithful as the light for the nations, and he proclaimed salvation through them to the ends of the earth. In the darkness of the world the faithful became the light of the People: The Lord is gracious, merciful and just. With the kindness and love of God, our Savior appeared; he saved us ... because of his mercy... *“Three mysteries mark this holy day: today the star leads the Magi to the infant Christ; today water is changed into wine for the wedding feast; today Christ wills to be baptized by John in the river Jordan to bring us salvation”*. Today we have come with gifts to adore the Lord, and today we ask, may the light of faith go before us always and everywhere; may this heavenly light of faith guide us into the life of the world to come, to the land of the living.

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD, Jan. 13, 2019

Augusty tłumaczył - **C+M+B+2019. Chrystus jest Dobrodziejem wszystkich w tym domu mieszkających przez Krzyż.** Dobrodziej=Benefaktor to znaczy nasz Zbawiciel. To tylko różne słowa wyrażające całą wielkość Miłosiernej Miłość, której uosobieniem jest Jezus. „*On jest Obliczem miłosierdzia*”- (papież Franciszek).
- Today the divine epiphany of the only begotten Son of God is proclaimed. Today the Magi from the East come. They are led by a star. They come and adore the Newborn man. Jesus comes to us as the Servant of God and people. Let every nation on earth adore Him, because he made Pagans a participant of salvation. Today we bless a chalk and we use it to write on our entrance door first letter of the names of wise men and we add the current year: **C + M + B + 2019**

This is a visible sign that we accept the Divine epiphany. St. Augustine explained it as; **Christus est multorum Benefactor = Christ is The Benefactor through the Cross for all who dwell in this house.** Pope Francis said: these different words express the whole greatness of God’s Merciful Love, which is personified in Jesus. He is the Face of Mercy.
