3. GALA ORGANIZING COMMITTEE: We would like to thank you all parishioners that quickly bought tickets for the Golden Jubilee of our Pastor Fr. Boguslaw, on June 14th. They are sold out! Hoping to see you all there; God bless you for your generosity and commitment to the parish.

4. FROM POLAND: The 15th anniversary of the beatification of Fr. Jerzy Popielusko— pastor of working people and Solidarity —took place, this week. His grave was visited by over 23 million believers. According to historian Prof. Pawel Skibiński, young people appreciate the clarity of Fr. Popielusko's intentions, the clarity of his message and moral transparency.

5. FROM THE VATICAN: Hundreds of AI-(artificial intelligence) generated fake sermons of Leo XIV leaked online. Millions of people have watched them, the Italian ANSA news agency reported. It added that the platforms on which the fake recordings appeared have already removed many of them. Let's use this announcement to keep aware of the real source of the news we read and receive in our digital devices: cell, computer with chats, Whatsapp, Facebook messages, videos from Tik Tok and other applications.

6. From the Church: Let's rekindle the Charism of GOD: Just as a dying fire cannot be rekindled by throwing huge wooden logs into it, a dying faith cannot be rekindled by great actions, but is strengthened by simple daily prayer, a few lines from the Bible. The definition of "charisma is : a work of grace, a gift, a benefit, or prosperity." In ancient Greece, it meant as a gift graciously offered to someone, without merit of their own. With the development of Christianity, it became known as special graces that God bestows on people. In the hectic world that we live in, let's take few minutes everyday to calm down, reflect and meditate in the passages of the Good Book that will give us Christian inspiration and guide in our daily actions.

7. Blessed Martyrs of Poland during the WWII (June 14): 108 Polish Catholics were killed by Nazis during the World War II. The group included 3 bishops, 52 priests, 26 men and 8 women from religious communities as well as 3 seminarians and 9 lay people. An example of their suffering and endurance could be read with the records about Fr. Bronislaw Komorowski, one of the priests killed in a concentration camp; confined in an underground cell, beaten and tortured to death.

The Law of the New Covenant is the Spirit of God and life. It is not written on stone tablets, nor in books or documents. For us Christians, just living could be dangerous if we don't explore what is the most valuable gift we have received: our internal, spiritual life. That is why today we hear that "The Spirit gives life, the flesh is of no use" God's love is poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who dwells in us. He unites the divided nations, so that each in his own language gives glory to God, so that the splendor of His glory may shine upon us. Today we ask Christ, Light from Light, to strengthen our hearts with the gift of the Holy Spirit as we were reborn to new life through baptism. Babel is a symbol of human pride and arrogance that brings confusion and despair. There is no common language or understanding among people. Only Truth can be the foundation of unity. Some believe that the Tower of Babel was a hand stretched out to heaven as a plea for help. If humanity today were to make such a gesture, it would be a step towards reconciliation with God and the unification of people and nations. This unification was first received by the saving work and sacrifice of Christ. Then, afterwards by the coming of the Holy Spirit as a unifying force that "holds all things together". The prophet Ezekiel sees the revival of the dead bones covering the valley. This vision means spiritual rebirth, because God has the power to bring the dead back to life. The Holy Spirit continues to renew the face of the earth and every spring we can admire it. Let us remember that whoever turns to God with trust will survive. Peter refers to this announcement of the Old Testament in his speech, on the Day of Pentecost. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit is a great gift of God. Jesus said: "Receive the Holy Spirit." He works in people and through people who are open to His gifts and to Himself. Therefore, today we pray: "Let Your Spirit descend and renew the earth." Behold, God comes to our aid in our weakness. St. Paul says: "In hope we are saved." The Holy Spirit awakens faith and hope in us, He teaches us to pray. He Himself prays in us and for us. He knows our misery and the desires of our hearts. Today we ask with confidence: "Come Holy Spirit, fill ..."

Here is a discreet announcement of the greatest Gift: the Holy Spirit, Lord and Giver of Life, who comes from the Father and the Son and who together with the Father and the Son receives adoration and glory, and today we trust that He will give us zeal flowing to the Holy Spirit and fill our hearts with His power, enabling us to live a noble life.

Monday , JUNE 9, 2025 THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY, MOTHER OF THE CHURCH

Mary, The Mother of the Church feast was instituted by Pope Francis on February 11, 2018 – on the 160th anniversary of the apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary at Lourdes. The title “Mother of the Church” was bestowed on HER during the Second Vatican Council, by Pope St. Paul VI. This celebration is observed on the Monday following Pentecost, all around the world. With the loving help of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may the Church be more fruitful, exulting in holiness, and may successfully draw to Her embrace, all the families of the people.

Maryja – Matka Kościoła, poczynając Chrystusa mocą Ducha Świętego, stała się Matką Kościoła mocą tego samego Ducha. Ona jest Matką każdego z nas, bo powiedziało Bogu w chwili Zwiastowania swoje „Tak”, dzięki któremu rozpoczęło się nasze zbawienie. Następny etap Macierzyństwa Maryi dokonał się pod Krzyżem Jezusa. Krew i woda, które wypłynęły z boku Chrystusa – dały początek Kościoło-wowi. „Niewiasto! Oto Syn Twój..., Oto Matka Twoje... Królowo Nieba wesel się, Alleluja, bo Ten, któregoś nosiła, Alleluja, Zmartwychwstał, jak powiedział. Alleluja” W jakimś sensie jesteśmy zrodzeni przez Maryję jako dzieci Boże. Ona współpracowała w naszych odrodzeniu duchowym. Ona jest Matka Kościoła ale jest także Córką. Obecność Maryi razem z apostołami w Wieczerniku, i w chwili Zesłania Ducha Świętego, POSIADA TO GŁĘBOKIE ZNACZENIE. Maryja jest wśród nich bez żadnej władzy. Apostołowie pójdą w świat nauczać i zakładać Kościoły; Maryja jakby znika, i w modlitewnej ciszy służy Ewangelii Chrystusa. Ona uczy nas pozostawiać inicjatywę Bogu. Ona uczy nas służyć - i dziś za to dziękujemy Ci, Maryjo.

Mary, conceived Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit and became the Mother of the Church by the power of the same Spirit. She is the Mother of each of us, because she said “Yes!” to God, at the moment of the Annunciation, thanks to which our salvation began. The next stage of Mary’s motherhood took place under the Cross of Jesus: the blood and water that flowed from the side of Christ gave rise to the Church. “Woman! Behold your Son..., Behold your Mother. Queen of Heaven, rejoice, Alleluia, for the One you bore, Alleluia, is risen, as he said. In a sense, we are born of Mary as children of God; she cooperated in our spiritual rebirth. She is the Mother of the Church, but she is also the Daughter. We ought to recognize the deep meaning of Mary’s presence, together with the apostles in the Cenacle, and at the moment of the Descent of the Holy Spirit. Mary is among them without any power, but She was there! The Apostles will go into the world to teach and establish the Church; Mary disappears, as it were, and in prayerful silence serves the Gospel of Christ, in other ways: SHE teaches us to leave the initiative to God. SHE teaches us to be humble, to serve - and today we thank you for that, Mother Mary.

FROM THE BIBLE: Prov.8.1, 10-11 “Does not Wisdom call, and Understanding raise her voice? Receive MY instruction in preference to silver, and knowledge rather than to chose gold. For Wisdom is better than any riches, and no choice possession can compare with her.”
