

Dear Loving parishioners,

Love and Peace of Christ!

Happy Father's Day to all who are fathers or grandfathers or stepfathers. Five weeks ago we observed Mother's Day and offered Mass for our moms. Today, on this Father's Day, we are doing the same, offering our dads - living or dead - on the altar of God during this Holy Mass, invoking our heavenly Father's blessings on them so that they may be remembered as loving, caring and disciplining, always available and willing to do for their children, whatever is needed to help them.
