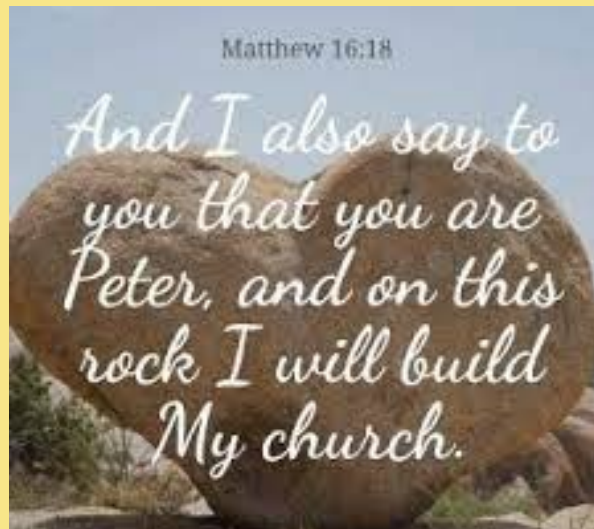

Do You Love to Iron?!

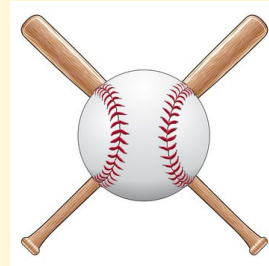
