



## Saint Jude the Apostle Easter Memorial Crosses

Each year at St. Jude, our parish lawn is filled with simple white crosses in celebration of Easter. Each cross bears the name of a loved one who has died and is placed as a visible sign of our hope in the Resurrection.



The Memorial Crosses are a beautiful way for families to remember those they love during the Easter season. As parishioners and visitors arrive for Easter Masses, the crosses serve as a powerful reminder that we are a communion of saints, prayer, memory, and hope. Forms for the Easter Memorial Crosses are available at all church entrances.




## Faith Formation

We will have a Rite of Welcome for our 8 OCIA candidates during the 8:30 Sunday mass this weekend. Later in the afternoon, we will attend the Rite of Election at the Cathedral with our 2 catechumens seeking full initiation into the church.

As we enter Lent, we encourage our children to complete 40 random acts of kindness to represent the 40 days of Lent. In addition, our Faith Formation classes will be giving alms to help our Food Ministry team. We have asked the children to bring in food to help the needy, and we will leave it for our Food Ministry to deliver the food to local agencies in the community.

How do we explain Lent to our children? Lent is a 40 day season to help us prepare and get our hearts ready for Easter. We use this time to grow closer to Jesus by imitating His 40 days in the desert. We do this by praying, sacrificing (giving things up) things and giving to others. During Lent, we fill our hearts with love for Jesus, and prepare for the joy of Easter.
