



Easter Memorial Crosses

Each year at St. Jude, our parish lawn is filled with simple white crosses in celebration of Easter. Each cross bears the name of a loved one who has died and is placed as a visible sign of our hope in the Resurrection. The Memorial Crosses are a beautiful way for families to remember those they love during the Easter season. As parishioners and visitors arrive for Easter Masses, the crosses serve as a powerful reminder that we are a communion of saints, prayer, memory, and hope. Forms for the Easter Memorial Crosses are available at all church entrances. If you have participated in the past, please indicate “PREVIOUS CROSS” at the bottom of the form. If your family has multiple crosses, please note this on one of the forms. We will do our best to keep your loved ones together on the lawn. Please use the space provided to list your family name (up to 24 characters). Kindly place your completed form in an envelope marked “Easter Memorial Crosses” along with a \$15.00 offering per cross. Faith Formation

As we travel through Lent, we encourage our children to complete 40 random acts of kindness to represent the 40 days of Lent. In addition, our Faith Formation classes will be giving alms to help our Food Ministry team. We have asked the children to bring in food to help the needy, and we will leave it for our Food Ministry to deliver the food to local agencies in the community. Thank you to our families who are responding to this request!!

Join us on Monday, March 16th for the third session on Reconciliation. **"Forgiven"** is a 5 week program explaining the Mystery of God's Grace in Confession, and it is streamed from Formed through the Augustinian Institute. Meet us at 12:45, with your own lunch or snacks, and join us for this insightful program! Coffee will be available!

Our **Confirmation candidates** will travel to Siena University for their confirmation retreat on Sunday, March 15th. Under the direction of the Assistant Campus Minister, Deacon Nick Ascioti, our children will join the Youth Ministers of Siena to share faith and prepare for Confirmation.

On Wednesday, March 18th, we will start **"First Steps in Faith"**, a story time for preschool children in our parishes. Our children will learn about Jesus and His Holy Church. We will be guided by the Holy Spirit through the memory of Derek Murphy, a parishioner and Faith Formation student, who lived his life following and loving the Lord. Story time will be every Wednesday from 10-11 am at St. Michael's.

Dan Jason, a missionary and Catholic author, will speak to our Faith Formation classes, and we invite St. Jude's and St. Michael's parishes to join us on Sunday, March 22nd at 11 am in the church hall. Dan's message will center on living our faith in everyday life, sharing God's love with others, and encouraging those whose faith may feel uncertain, but who are hungry to grow. His story, ministry work, and recent experiences, including his work with the poor and orphans and his upcoming missionary trip to India will offer a meaningful and relatable witness for our young people and parish community.

Mark your calendars to attend **Stations of the Cross** at St. Jude's on Friday, March 27th at 6:30 pm. Our Confirmation and OCIA students will be part of a LIVE presentation where they will be behind a screen depicting the crucifixion of Christ. Our next practice will be held on Thursday, March 19th, 6:30 pm, at St. Jude's.

We are excited to say that we have recently purchased a subscription to **"FORMED"** by the Augustinian Institute. This digital resource provides on-demand Catholic faith based materials. It is sometimes described as a "Catholic Netflix", and it offers movies, studies, ebooks and audio material. Faith Formation will be using it as another resource to teach our faith. It is also available to parishioners and families of St. Jude and St. Michael to explore the Catholic faith. It is FREE to all parishioners-to enroll, go to formed.org/signup and follow the prompts to create an account. It will ask you for the church zip code, please enter 12180.
