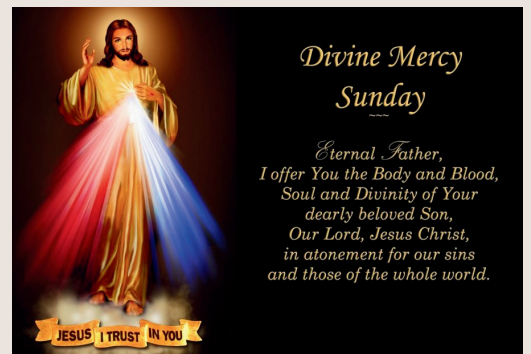

Our "First Steps in Faith" Program, a story time for preschool children is off to a great start! This new program is teaching our preschoolers about Jesus and His Holy Church. We are guided by the Holy Spirit through the memory of Derek Murphy, a parishioner and Faith Formation student, who lived his life following and loving the Lord. Story time is held every Wednesday from 10-11 am at St. Michael's.

Don't forget to enroll in our subscription to "FORMED" by the Augustinian Institute. This digital resource provides on-demand Catholic faith based materials. It is sometimes described as a "Catholic Netflix", and it offers movies, studies, ebooks and audio material. Faith Formation will be using it as another resource to teach our faith. It is also available to parishioners and families to explore the Catholic faith. It is FREE to all parishioners-to enroll, go to formed.org/signup and follow the prompts to create an account. It will ask you for the church zip code, please enter 12180. Click on the St. Michael's address when it pops up, and you are into the subscription. 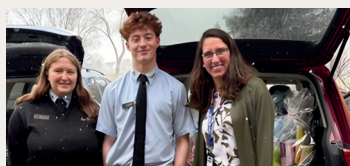


GRADUATING SENIOR? APPLY FOR A \$1,000 PARISH SCHOLARSHIP
