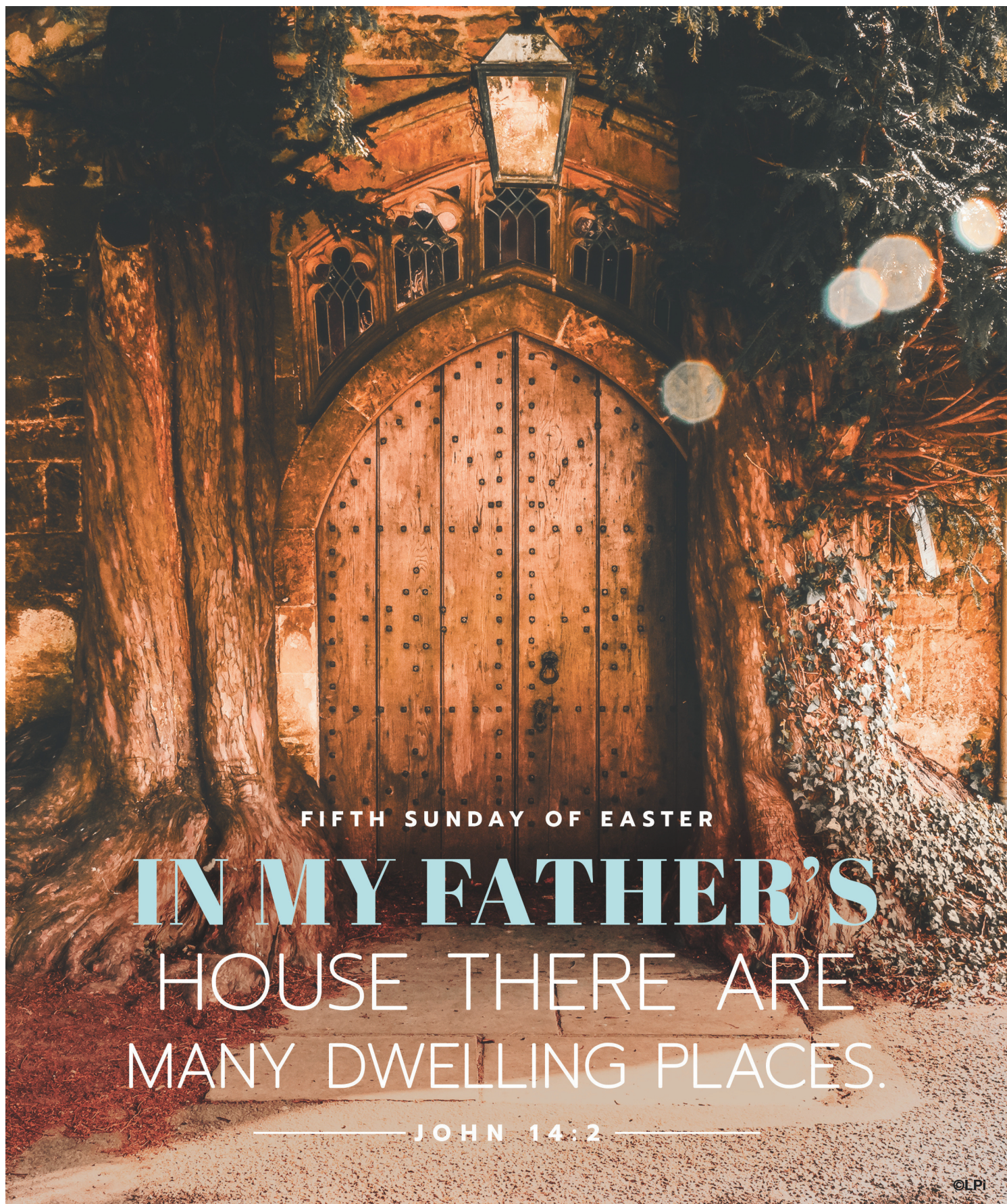

ROSARY ALTAR SOCIETY

The Rosary Altar Society of St. Jude the Apostle church is open to all women of St. Jude's. The purpose of this ministry is to gain spiritual strength through our Blessed Mother, to meet socially and to support care to our altar and worthy community activities.
