ASH WEDNESDAY is March 2. While it is not a holy day of obligation, and receiving ashes is not a requirement, attending Mass on Ash Wednesday is a good way spiritually to begin Lent. Because of the risk of spreading disease during the coronavirus pandemic, the minister is not to touch the recipient, and the ashes are not to be smeared on the forehead. Instead, the Vatican Congregation for Divine Worship has asked that we follow the ancient practice found in Rome and in a number of countries where ashes are sprinkled on the top of the head. So, following Communion, the priest will address all those present at one time, saying "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." Communion ministers will then go to the foyer and sprinkle ashes over each person as they leave the church building.

**COLLECTION FOR BLACK AND INDIAN MISSIONS** in the United States will be taken up at all Masses next weekend March 5-6. Please place your contribution in the black box in the church foyer.

A SPECIAL DIOCESAN COLLECTION will be taken up on Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022, for three important causes: the Church in Latin America, the Church in Africa, and the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. Our gifts will be joined with contributions from Catholics throughout the United States to provide grants that fund projects to build new churches, form priests and religious, and train lay evangelization leaders for local parish communities. **FASTING AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT:** The law of abstinence obliges those 14 years of age and older not to eat meat. The law of fast obliges all those from 18 through 59 to refrain from eating between meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two light meals each day. Ash Wednesday, March 2, and Good Friday, April 15, are days of both fast and abstinence. In the United States, all Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.

RITE OF SENDING for the Catechumens and Candidates participating in the RCIA program here at Holy Family will be celebrated at the 9:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, March 6, 2022. At this time, those preparing for the Easter sacraments will be affirmed and sent forth by our parish community to Sacred Heart Cathedral in San Angelo where Bishop Sis will accept the election of the Catechumens and recognize the Candidates who are also preparing for full initiation into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil on April 16, 2022.

PARISH FALL-FEST 2022: The Pastor has appointed Ms. Rochelle Johnson as the chair of the upcoming Parish Fall-Fest 2022 to be held on the Holy Family Grounds. The Pastoral and Finance Councils of our parish will help and coordinate the event with the chairperson. The date, day, and event-related news will be announced soon. As we are restarting this Parish-Fest after many years, we will need many volunteers and group leaders. Please get ready to support this parish endeavor. Thank you.


